The Katandra Football Netball Club supports the codes of conduct as introduced by AFL, Football Victoria and Netball Victoria

Players Code of Conduct

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators
- 2. Care and respect the uniform and the equipment provided to you
- 3. Cooperate with your coach in relation to training programs that prepare your for competition
- 4. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train
- 5. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality
- 6. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times
- 7. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification
- 8. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team
- 9. Do no engage in practises that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco & drug use)
- 10. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual or other harassment
- 11. Do not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability in any forum as this may be determined as an act of bullying and/or harassment

Junior Players Code of Conduct

- 1. Play by the rules of the game and the rules of the club
- 2. Participate fairly and safely and abide by decisions of the umpire and/or official
- 3. Be a team player and ensure that at all times your behaviour is fair
- 4. Cooperate with your coach and other players
- 5. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately fouling or provoking an opponent and throwing/damaging equipment is not acceptable or permitted
- 6. Be a patient and enthusiastic supporter of fellow players
- 7. Be a responsible team member and always be on time and attend all training sessions
- 8. Ensure you always bring the appropriate uniform and equipment to training and/or matches
- 9. Do not engage in practises that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco & drug use)
- 10. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play including volunteers (scorers, coaches, timekeepers, administrators & umpires)
- 11. Do not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability in any forum as this may be determined as an act of bullying and/or harassment

Parents & Supporters Code of Conduct

- 1. Encourage participation, but do not force it
- 2. Applaud good performance and efforts by all players.
- 3. Respect the umpires and never publicly criticise umpires. Raise personal concerns with club officials in private
- 4. Recognise all volunteers who are giving of their time to provide recreation activities for players
- 5. Show respect for your teams coach and opponents. Without them there would be no game
- 6. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by no using foul language, and not harassing administrators, coaches, players and umpires
- 7. Support the use of age appropriate development activities

We support the club in its undertakings and encourage the club to take necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, parents and spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct
