Rosters can be submitted earlier with team entries; all fields must be completed.

N.B: The player fee is for all of 2017 regardless of how many teams/leagues an individual represents. Teams not submitting a player roster by May 15<sup>th</sup> will be invoiced for 12 players per team.

- Please ensure teams are entered in the correct grades; if necessary in the first 2-3 weeks Blitz style (grading) games will run to ensure teams are playing in correct grades.

### Terms & Conditions of Entry:

1. All entries must be made on the official entry form.
2. All players must be registered on the official team roster form by due date.
3. Players cannot play in a competition below their year level at school and cannot play in a team below the level of the team they are registered with. Players can play up a grade for two games. If they play up a third time they are automatically regraded to the higher team. To be eligible for play offs players must have played at least two competition games for a team prior to play offs.
4. All teams must play in matching numbered shirts. As many schools wear the same colour it is recommended that alternative strips are available. When both teams are wearing same or similar coloured tops the referee will require Team A to wear alternative strip (or bibs as provided).
5. Teams withdrawing after the publication of the draw will be liable for the full team entry fee and player registrations due. All costs incurred in the collection of overdue accounts will be payable by the school.
6. Only players named on the roster may play – to add additional players contact Basketball Hawkes Bay. Basketball Hawkes Bay reserves the right to re-grade a team based on team performance.
7. Teams unable to play games as scheduled in the draw must notify Basketball Hawkes Bay well in advance. Responsibility for rescheduling matches lies with the team unable to play as per the schedule provided. Late notification or failure to notify will result in the forfeiting team receiving a fine.
8. Teams are to supply at least one person for the scorebench for their own game. Failure to complete your score bench duty will result in a fine of \$30.00 for the first offence, \$60.00 for the second offence and so on.
9. All disputes/incidents should be notified in writing to Basketball Hawkes Bay.
10. Basketball Hawkes Bay supports and encourages good on-court and side-line behavior. This extends to players, coaches, managers, supporters and spectators, who are all considered part of the team. Our Zero Tolerance Policy applies to ALL of the team.
11. All local competition rules including fees and fines are contained in the local competitions By Laws, Rules and Regulations document which is available on the Basketball Hawkes Bay website. Please make sure you read that document.

By entering a team it is deemed that you have agreed to abide by the terms and conditions of entry and have made yourself familiar with the rules and bylaws.
