The 2008 season has been extremely successful for the South Croydon Football Club both on and off the field.

To Peter Allwood I also again thank you on an excellent job in your role as coach in 2008 and look forward to an even more successful 2009 for the colts.

Good luck to all the top age colts' players who will now become part of the open age group of the senior club.

The reserves season was an absolute ripper in 2008.

With many new players pulling on the boots for the reserves and the experiences gained from 2007 the reserves were very optimistic of a good season in 2008.

After round 5 with only 1 win on the board the doomsayers were out in voice but luckily the coaching staff and players weren't listening.

As the season progressed the reserves built momentum and gradually started working to the desired game plan.

With their focus being on team orientated football they started playing some very exciting and rewarding football.

It was a pleasure to watch the team develop into a very skilful running outfit that shared the ball around and protected each other.

The home and away season produced 11 wins and 7 losses and got the reserves into 4th spot on the ladder and a return to finals football in 2nd division.

Runner up in 2006, 6th place in 2007 and Runner up in 2008 are great achievements as a coach.

The senior team had a difficult yet successful year in 2008.

Treasurers Report.

The treasurer's role in 2008 has been one of learning. There have been significant improvements in the recording of income and expenses to enable proper classification and this will continue for next season.

Due to the problems of 2007, significant time was spent reworking the 2007 numbers which resulted in the figures presented at the special general meeting.

The final figures for 2008 show a profit of over \$12,000- which is a significant improvement on last year's \$1300. This result was achieved off the back of some excellent improvements in fundraising via both functions and sponsorship, though there were also some increases in expenses, especially in fielding teams each week.

The following notes will assist in understanding the financials better.

Bar Sales – the margin on sales has decreased based on these figures, however this is offset as bar takings have been included in the Social revenue, yet only a small amount of the expense was charged to the Social expenses. Overall, we are very happy with the improvements in the bar trade this year. For 2009 we will ensure better recording is in place to better reflect the bar margins

Canteen – Margins have improved, on a slightly higher turnover for the year

Social Functions – This year full better records enabled us to provide a fuller picture of Social event which have been netted out in previous reports. Additional functions, all well attended, has seen a good improvement here.

Memberships and Donations – All have improved, especially the Sponsorship due to the hard work undertaken in that area

Uniform/Equipment – Again, better records have enabled this to be more accurately captured. The offsetting expense is included under Player Associated Costs

Player Associated Costs – these have increased as a result of higher medical costs (staff and supplies), higher uniform costs and player payments increasing

Game Day costs – These increased in part due to higher water/electricity charges, and better recording of expenses eg boundary and waterboy payments etc which previously went unrecorded.
