Gaining a few key recruits in the off season made a world of difference to the club.

Round 1 saw us travel to Mulgrave and things were looking great when we were 28 points up mid way through the 3rd quarter. Then the wheels fell off and we lost by 52 points. Reality set in as we were taught a lesson by the 2008 runner up.

From that loss the team started to build into the season and eventually got to the top of the ladder in Round 18 after a 2 point victory over Donvale. The home and away record was 15 wins and 3 losses which was a great result but we were still a long way from the final reward.

The second semi final saw us up against our nemesis in Mulgrave and again they managed to beat us by 4 points. That meant Mulgrave had beaten us the last 6 times in a row.

The following week we met Rowville in the preliminary final and came out victors by 8 points which set up the grand final everybody wanted to see.

Treasurer's Report.

It is with great pleasure that I present my first treasurer's report covering season 2009.

Having been the treasurer at the Ringwood Cricket Club I thought that I would be well prepared for the role at South Croydon. I was wrong! The activity and intensity was a massively large leap and it took me a while to acclimatise.

It also seemed like a year of fire fighting with many unforeseen issues coming to the fore. First we had the "light tower" issue – thankfully went up just as winter hit. Then we had Consumer Affairs Victoria not accepting our annual return and statement by public officer for last year as our trading circumstances had changed and we were bound to supply a set of audited financial statements. We hired the services of "BWW Accountants" and I am indebted to Paul Warburton for his patience and understanding as we worked through last year's results.

However, the good news is as this process is now in place I am in a position to present a full set of audited results for this season, they are included for your perusal in this report.

I would like to highlight some areas regarding the financial performance of our club.

The final result shows a trading profit of \$3,684. This result was achieved with an increase of 6.95% in income and a 15.34% increase in expenditure. The main expenditure increase was 22.69% in player associated costs.

The cash position of the club, however, decreased by \$5,532 as the cost of the light tower will be amortized over future years.

Bar – we are indebted to Kate Timms and all the volunteers who work behind the bar. The bar achieved a wonderful profit increase of \$10,012 over last season.

Canteen – The canteen figures include match day, match day BBQ and Thursday night teas. Again we have wonderful support from Ronda Stone, the "Horney Burger BBQ Crew" and new comer Kerryn Nixon to thank. The total result was a profit increase of \$3,406 over last season. The Thursday night teas this season were a hit and returned a 163.6% profit increase over last season.

Social Functions – Here we must thank Raj Ramadge for all her work in not only running the social functions but raising the standard in delivering quality functions for all members and players.

Merchandise – Bryan King rules this area with an iron fist and makes a treasurer's job easy as he notes and collects everything – thanks Bryan.

Expenditure – The club worked hard in containing costs and achieved a 6.2% increase (excluding player costs) which is a pleasing result.

NEXT season – the wonderful on field performance of our club has resulted in first division football coming to Cheong Park next season. This will bring a whole new set of challenges and we all need to be prepared. A planning meeting has already been held and a budget meeting will be held early in the New Year.

Finally I would like to thank my wife Dianne – when I took the job on I underestimated the time required by many fold. I broke a lot of promises this season – Thanks for your understanding.

Colts 2009

After some good recruitment pickups and a solid pre season we were confident of doing well in the new season ahead. Of course, all that would depend on what the other clubs had been doing over the off season.

We got off to the best possible start with an away win against 2008 premiers Mulgrave even with some players missing through illness & injury. Comfortable wins in the next three rounds against Waverley Blues, Ringwood & Bayswater saw us move into second position behind Montrose. A hard fought win against a big Doncaster side saw us retain that position on the ladder and enable us to go into round 6 undefeated against top side Montrose also undefeated. The clash the following week lived up to the expectation. In a see-sawing affair we were able to hold off a fast finishing Montrose to win by 8 points and take top spot on the ladder. Round 7 saw us take on Rowville at home who were a game behind in 3rd. What a difference a week makes as we were comprehensively defeated by a very good, tall, running side. At that stage Rowville were easily the best side we had played. Two more wins saw us 2nd at the halfway mark of the season.

Mulgrave turned the table on us in round 10 to get the job done by 11 points. Two away wins against bottom sides Waverley Blues & Ringwood followed. Doncaster were the next opponent at home. For three quarters Bayswater dominated to be 6 goals up at the last change. We came home hard to go down by a mere 5 points and had enough chances to get the job done but it wasn't to be. We lost our centre half back with a dislocated shoulder in the second quarter and we wasn't to play again. It was to be an injury that was to change the way we played with the side having to be rearranged for the remainder of the year. It meant that we had no spare tails and that other key position players had to take a turn in the ruck. Round 14 saw a good win against Doncaster with the boys playing their best football for the second half of the season. Montrose came to Cheong with intent in round 15 and thrashed us to the tune of 50 points. A trip to Rowville the following week saw us go down again by 8 points. A 2 point deficit with only minutes to go saw them get the clearance and goal. This loss saw us drop to fourth on the ladder. A win against Doncaster East was then followed by a loss to Donvale. On paper the loss against Donvale was a real disappointment but the fact that they had 5 TAC players in their side that day and we really played well considering the size difference between the 2 sides gave us confidence going into the finals. Finishing fourth we would play Mulgrave in the first semi final.

We started the first semi against Mulgrave full of running but missed opportunities in front of goal. We were slightly ahead at quarter time. We again had most of the ball in the second quarter to move ahead by a couple of goals. Our key indicators showed that we were restricting their ball use and giving them no chance to run with the ball. This trend continued for the next half and we finished 24 point winners. Interestingly Tackles & 1%'s were season high numbers. The boys really wanted this one.

The preliminary final saw us up against Rowville a side we had not beaten in the past 2 years. We knew we would have to play our best football to have any chance of winning. Rowville had the upper hand early as we again missed chances in front of goal. We were having trouble holding their runners who were providing their tall forwards with plenty of opportunities. The final change saw us 13points down kicking into a gale. Rowville kicked 2 goals in the first 2 minutes and it was game over.

Third place, 13 wins including a final in 2009, what a great achievement.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Quony and his committee for giving me the chance to coach the colts for the past 2 years. To football manager, John Dinnell, especially, thanks for all you work, help & advice over the past 2 years. Thanks also to Paris and his senior coaching staff for making the colts feel part of the South Croydon family. To Phil Lovell, in particular, who was our forward scout this season. Our great start to the season was on the back of all your work.

To all the people who were "hands on" every week. Thanks to Rob Mallison, Les Humphris, & Brendan Shalvey, who gave their time & knowledge to help coach the boys.
