Treasurer's Report.

It is with great pleasure that I present my second treasurer's report covering season 2010.

After last year's challenges we are again in a position to present a full set of audited results for this season and they are included here for your perusal.

I would like to highlight some areas regarding the financial performance of our club:

The final result shows a trading profit of \$1,396. This result was achieved with a decrease of 0.93% in income and a 0.06% decrease in expenditure.

The good news is that the cash position of the club has increased by \$4825 compared to last year's decrease of \$5,532 which included the cost of the new light tower.

Bar – we are indebted to Kate Timms and all the volunteers who work behind the bar. The bar achieved a profit increase of \$1,230 over last season.

Canteen – The canteen figures include match day, match day BBQ and Thursday night dinners. Again we had the wonderful support of Kerryn Nixon and all the Thursday night helpers and the "Horney Burger BBQ Crew". The total result was a profit increase of \$774- over last year.

Social Functions – Here we must thank Tracey Adams for all her work in not only running the social functions, but in raising the standard in delivering quality functions for all members and players. This season the social functions increased their profits by a wonderful \$10,179-.

Merchandise – Bryan King rules this area with an iron fist and makes a treasurer's job easy as he notes and collects everything, thanks Bryan.

Expenditure – The club worked hard in containing costs and achieved a 0.06% decrease which was pleasing.

Next season – I think you will agree that to achieve our final position in first division on revenues of \$261k would be the envy of ever EFL club. Everyone at the club deserves a pat on the back for the selfless attitude which brings us this result.

However, to be more successful in first division we need to raise the bar and find a further increase in revenue that will help bring a consistent first division status.

Finally, I would like to thank my wife Dianne – since I have gone back to work, she has done most of the banking and running around for me. I could not have continued as treasurer without her! – Thanks.
