Score bench responsibilities

Scoring - How to Score

Timing – Normal Rounds and Finals

Direction arrow – Jump balls

Time outs

The score bench will now assist the umpires on time outs. Time outs go for 1 minute from the time the umpire calls time out.

The scorebench is to time the timeout. At the 50 second mark the buzzer is to be pushed to alert the umpire and players they have 10 seconds to the resumption of play.

Signing in Players

The scorers can now tick off players, this doesn't need to be done by the umpire. The umpires will however verify the players are there, this includes fill in and injured players.

Late Players: when the player arrives, they need to notify the score bench that they have arrived. The scorers then jointly confirm that the player is there, write name/ number on score sheet and at a time out/half time inform the umpire there is a new player on score sheet & they will verify this. The player is able to take the court once the scorers have written their details on the score sheet.

TMs should check all players details on scoresheet before the game

Registered players

Double check name and numbers are correct.

Injured players

Players who are injured and not playing but attend the game will be able to fill in their details on the back of the scoresheet. This will then be counted as a game for finals qualification. There will be a separate spot for this on the back of the sheet.

Fill in players

Fill in players will now put their details on the back of the scoresheet. There will be a specific area for this. Their name and number will also need to be added underneath the rest of the teams on the front of the scoresheet.
