The last training session was action packed and the boys worked hard in the wet conditions. The session finished in the club rooms with a visual presentation compiled by Richard Wickham. The presentation consisted of motivational messages and various pictures of the team that were taken throughout the season.

Grand final day had finally arrived and the boys were pumped. They knew they were up against a tough opponent who were undefeated throughout the season, but The Hawks were determined to do their best. After a few warm up drills and a group huddle, the boys burst out of the rooms and ran through an inspiring banner which was kindly put together by Hayley Addison (mother of Max.)

Max Addison was the captain for the day and The Hawks won the toss and elected to kick with the wind. They got off to a sensational start and kept possession of the ball for the majority of the quarter. Murrumbeena were applying pressure but the Hawks were way too strong. Last Sunday saw us play our final game, a well-fought battle against Mordialloc Braeside. Unfortunately the weather was not on our side, and with a win needed to progress through to the grand-final, it was going to be a tough game.

Physicality is always an issue against Mordialloc but utilising quick movement and trying to work the ball long into our forward line proved a solid tactic with the game evenly controlled for the first half, we were just unable to convert this promising play into score and reel in the gap they had made.
