

Awards Selection Criteria Policy

Award Nomination Process

Members may put forward nominations for awards in writing (or e-mail) to the GM of TBI. Nominations for awards may also be put forward by the TBI Management Committee or GM for consideration by the appointed Selection Panel.

Nominations will be accepted from 2 months prior to the Junior Representative Awards Dinner for a period of one month. If no nominations are received for an award category the TBI Management Committee or GM will supply nominations for consideration of the appointed Selection Panel.

Selection Panel

The Selection Panel will be appointed by the TBI Management Committee. The Selection Panel is to be comprised of the TBI GM (Chairperson) and minimum of 3 of the following:

- TBI Coaching Director
- Local Legends
- QBL Head Coaches
- QBL Chairperson
- Or otherwise qualified person(s) deemed suitable by the TBI Management Committee

If the GM of TBI is unavailable at the time of selection a TBI Management Committee member will be appointed to chair the Selection Panel.

All considerations for awards will follow the criteria as listed below for each category. The Selection Panel will put forward their recommendations to the TBI Management Committee for consideration. The Selection Panel's recommendations should include the top 3 nominees in each category in preferential order where possible. The TBI Management Committee may at its discretion reject a nominee due to reasons outside the knowledge of the Selection Panel. In such a case, the TBI Board will choose the next nominee from the Selection Panel's preferential list.

Awards Selection Criteria

1. TBI Local Legend

TBI Local Legend acknowledges basketball players who have reached legendary status by achieving at the highest levels of basketball having played their way through the local Townsville junior and senior ranks. Townsville Basketball will, at regular periods launch a three metre banner with the Legend's name and photo inside the Stadium where it will hang for all to admire and aspire to achieve. The Local Legend(s) will be considered at TBI Management Committee level after nominations are put forward by the appointed selection panel. This award is not limited to a single recipient if more than one person fits the criteria. If there are no nominees that fit the selection criteria then the award will not be present.

Selection Criteria

- Must have played junior and senior club basketball at Townsville Basketball

- The candidate must have represented Townsville Basketball at the junior level in the U12, U14, U16 or U18 age groups
- Played at a minimum 4 of the following levels:
 - Represented QLD at an Australian Junior Championships
 - Townsville in the QBL
 - NBL or WNBL
 - NBA or WNBA
 - Australian Representative at any level
- The selection panel in exceptional circumstances may award local legend status to a player who may not have met all the minimum levels for recognition. Recognition of this status from time to time may be based on the extraordinary achievements of any individual player.

2. TBI Male Junior Player of the Year

The Junior Male Player of the Year will be a male player in the U18 age group or lower, who has attained a level of excellence greater than that achieved by their peers or whose performance has been so exceptional that their achievements have identified them as being clearly outstanding from their peers. They will have played in the Representative program in the relative season for the duration of the season, unless their achievements affected their ability to participate at any certain point in the season. These performances must be of such standard of excellence and achieved in an arena competitive enough to truly warrant them becoming the recipient of this award. Performance as a State Team representative at National Titles, National representation, the QBL or NBL will be taken into consideration.

These performances must be of such standard of excellence and achieved in an arena competitive enough to truly warrant them becoming the recipient of this award. Performance as a State Team representative at National Titles, National representation, the QBL or NBL will be taken into consideration.

6. TBI Representative Coach of the Year

The Coach of the Year will be a coach who has made a significant contribution to the development and success of a team or teams that they have coached. They will have coached in the Representative program during the relative season for the duration, unless their achievements affected their ability to participate at any certain point in the season the contribution of the coach to the development of the game and improving the standard of basketball coaching in Townsville Basketball will also be taken into consideration. Performance at an Australian Junior Championship, National representation, the QBL or W/NBL will be taken into consideration.

7. TBI Representative Official of the Year

The Official of the Year will be a person who has excelled in the field of officiating, i.e. refereeing, scoring or statistics, and whose performance sets them apart from their peers. The nominee's achievements may have been in officiating, the development or management of officials within the Townsville Basketball representative or Club season.

8. TBI Representative Manager of the Year

The Representative Manager of the Year is a volunteer who has excelled in their organization and team management and will have completed all tasks and responsibilities outlined in the Managers Handbook exceptionally well and in a timely manner. These performances must be of such standard of excellence and achieved in an arena competitive enough to truly warrant them becoming the recipient of this award.

- Attitude in performance
- Contribution to basketball in Townsville
- Past record of nominee

9. TBI Volunteer of the Year

The TBI Volunteer of the Year will be an individual who contributes to basketball voluntarily. The recipient of this Award may be an administrator, coach, official, sports trainer, etc. as long as they receive no remuneration (apart from reimbursement of expenses incurred) in respect of their duties. Consideration should be given for past contributions, but with emphasis on current representative season. Their achievements as a volunteer must be of a standard of excellence to have set themselves apart from their peers to warrant them becoming the recipient of this Award. No task is too much trouble and they are always willing to help in a friendly and helpful manner.
