



Water Person (Club)

Objective

- To supply water to their players on field in accordance with the S.F.L. Handbook point 3.4.3. and S.F.L. By-Law 5.3

Responsibilities

- Water Persons shall enter the arena for the sole purpose of supplying drinks to players
- They shall deliver the required drinks to the player/s then leave the field immediately.
- They shall not engage in coaching or barracking whilst on the field of play.
- Clubs to ensure water persons are responsible persons and a minimum of 12 years of age.
- They shall be dressed in white football shorts and a pink shirt with their Club name in bold letters in black and the word "WATER" in bold black letters clearly marked on the back of the shirt.

Relationships

- Their team players and Team Manager

Accountability

- Reports and are Accountable to the Team Manager

AFL Rules of the Game

- **13.5 OFFICIAL WITHIN FIFTY-METRE ARC**
 - Unless attending to an injured Player or making every endeavour to vacate the area, no Official is permitted within the Fifty-Metre Arc during the time when a defensive Player is preparing to Kick or in the act of Kicking the football back into play after a Behind has been scored.
 - Where an Official contravenes this Law, the opposing Team shall be awarded a Free Kick at the back line of the Centre Square, to be taken by the Player from the opposing Team who is closest to that location.
