SGL	<p>June 3rd behavioural incident was resolved between West and South.</p> <p>Drug and Alcohol Seminar at Lions was a success. Another workshop to be held on 5th September 2017.</p> <p>Mini-league match to be held on 26th August 2017 at half-time between West and South (League).</p> <p>Resolved that regarding any events planned to be held on match days, it is deemed professional and an act of courtesy, to raise these matters at League Meetings.</p> <p>Perhaps NAIDOC matches could be held in conjunction with a Multi-cultural round and programmed during the season similar to the MAC round.</p> <p>PPJFL is keen to promote and formulate a Girls Junior Football Competition, and even though numbers will probably be low initially, time will allow it to evolve and expand.</p> <p>An U14 girl wishing to play at an U15 level must go through a formal procedure, including written parental permission.</p> <p>Burley to be League supplier of footballs as they have offered a \$1,000 sponsorship and will provide footballs for all finals matches. Footballs cost \$86 and are \$49 cheaper than Sherrin.</p> <p>Blue to arrange Tribunal Education Workshop for Club Officials and Tribunal Commissioners prior to 2018 season.</p> <p><u>Drawn Final Series Matches:</u></p> <p>That where any Finals Series matches, in all grades, are drawn at full time then additional time of five (5) minutes, with time on, is to be played each end.
