Well we are getting close to the End of the 2018 Season for our Junior Teams. Following final matches of the draw, each Age Group Under 6's to Under 10's will participate in a Gala Day (Round Robin) similar to the preseason Gala Day – throughout August.

Under 6/7's Gala Day – 5th August at Batemans Bay (Hanging Rock Ovals)

Under 8/9's Gala Day – 12th August at Bodalla

Under 10's Gala Day – 19th August at Clyde (Surfside Ovals)

After players have completed their matches at the Gala Day – the Eurobodalla Football Association (EFA) hands out medallions to all the Players. This is a fun day out for players and families – not to be missed! The Club will then hold its Junior Presentation Afternoon for Under 6's to Under 10's on Saturday 25th August at Club Catalina from 2 – 3pm. This is an event where we celebrate our players, teams and Coaches. Each player on each team receives a trophy. Also, Coaches from teams may award special awards to players. We also have our Gold Sponsors in attendance as well. Following the presentation, we are also holding a disco to celebrate the end of season for the players from 3 – 5 pm. Winners and prizes from the Player World Cup Football Competition will also be announced and presented.

In order to organise player bags for the Presentation, we need to presell tickets to our Presentation Event so that we can arrange to the correct number of player bags for the afternoon. Tickets are \$5/player and can be purchased from the Canteen at training and game days prior to the Presentation. Reminder, when the weather turns - it is a good idea to check on Facebook - for any advice on ground closures. Or Forfeits. This will be advised on Facebook. Always check first thing Sunday morning - Game Day!

Also for Training Afternoons - if the weather turns bad or Council works and we need to cancel - it will be advised via Facebook & if known in advance via email.

Forfeits

Just a reminder that if a player is unable to attend a game - please ensure that you advise the coach as soon as possible. This means, prior to game day, if at all possible. It also means where there is an away game, it is imperative that the coach is aware if there will be enough players to field a team - rather than have to travel and discover it will be a forfeit because there is not enough players to field a team. By now, all the coaches will have advised their preferred communication method.

This is a reminder that all our players must behave appropriately – at Training, with fellow players, Coaches, at Matches with team mates, opposition players and Match Officials. Please remind your children that they need to be a Good Sport and Play by the Rules. This poster is also on our Club Facebook Page – along with other Play by the Rules Posters & the Club Website. Also, player membership of any Football NSW Club – which includes players, parents, guardians, coaches, officials - we are all expected to follow the FFA Code of Conduct and Spectator Code of Conduct – also found on our Club Website.

- **Treat your opponents the way you would like to be treated**
- **Thank the opposition at the end of the game**

Respect Officials

- **Accept and respect the Official's decision**
- **Thank the Official at the end of the match**
- **If you have an issue, raise it in a professional way with your Coach or Captain after the game.**

A little something to remember...

By now, most players and parents will have realised that it takes a Community of like-minded people to help run a Club and keep a Club moving forwards. All of us parents, with player children, cannot underestimate the effort and energy our Coaches put into their individual teams and players on training days and match days, home games and away games and away from the Club.

Sometimes, our Coaches are unavailable, sometimes at training and sometimes on Match Days – due to events outside of their control – e.g. work trips/commitments, sick children, family commitments etc. This is when parents can play a greater support role on their child's team as a fill-in Coach/Team Manager for a day. At training sessions, please help support your Coach. For match days, Coaches will try to make alternate arrangements – but with Parent support – this will make it easier when circumstances are beyond their control.

Regardless of Coach Absences at training, the Club will still hold training, which may result in combining players with other teams. The Club would not normally be emailing families about Coach absences on training days. Again, parents helping their child's team also helps their child.

As we near the Junior Presentation, it is a good idea to remember the Coaches. This is a good time for team parents and players to think about how they will recognise their child's coach.
