

AAM Advisory League Season 2 2018 Memo

It's been a year since TSG has been formed and we have had an exciting year with growth at the grassroots along with the excitement of sending 3 teams to Youth World Cup (YWC) next month along with the selection of the current 7 National Teams to compete in Touch World Cup (TWC) 2019.

With the TWC approaching, the TSG Executive Committee will be experimenting some initiatives for this upcoming League where there will be 6 National Teams competing in the league to enable them to be exposed to competition week in and out.

With this initiative, there will be considerable movement of players so TSG is publishing this Memo to establish clarity on what's going on. Please see below for guidelines for AAM Advisory League Season 2 2018 with regards to the categories affected by National Teams Participation.

Firm Rules

1. All players in the Men's Premiership and Women's Premiership are strictly to only play in the division and not drop below. This is to ensure the players in the lower grades have a fair chance of developing and progressing their game. The only exception is this rule are the players in the Men's 30s Team (because most of them are B players) and Players who are under age of 18 as of 1st Jan 2018.

2. To protect the integrity of the league, no national teams will be allowed to contest in the finals series which will only be contested by clubs.

3. Players are only allowed to play either Mixed Premiership OR Mixed B OR Mixed C (if this happens)

4. All players except for those in Rule 1, are only allowed to float one grade up OR down. Therefore one player can only play in 2 divisions in a Category.



5. TSG will, to the best of her ability, schedule the fixtures but clashes will be inevitable with the multiple floating scenarios. National Coaches and Club Coaches are advised to work together to achieve win-win situations.

A. Mixed Premiership

1. National Mixed Open Team - Only allowed to play in this team for this division.

2. National Women's Open Team - Squad of 22(?), 14 to be selected every week by Wednesday, 8 players to be allowed to return to their clubs to play Mixed Premiership only. (Because all WO players expected to play Women's Premiership, thus not allowed to play Mixed B.)

3. National Women's 27s Team - Squad of 22(?), 14 to be selected every week by Wednesday, 8 players to be allowed to return to their clubs to play Mixed Premiership or Mixed B (if the player is not playing Women's Premiership)

B. Men's Premiership

4. National Men's 30s Team - Squad of 22(?), 14 to be selected every week by Wednesday, 8 players to be allowed to return to their clubs to play Men's Premiership or Men's B. (They are also allowed to play Mixed B as technically they are recognized as 'B' players.

C. Men's B Grade

5. National Men's 40s Team - Squad of 22(?), 14 to be selected every week by Wednesday, 8 players to be allowed to return to their clubs to play Men's B or Men's C Grade.

D. Men's C Grade

6. National Men's 50s Team - Squad of 25(?), 14 to be selected every week by Wednesday, 11 players to be allowed to return to their clubs to play Men's B or Men's C Grade or Social D Grade
