## PREVIEW—ROUND 17

In the Hunter Haval Black Diamond Cup this Saturday, Warners Bay head to Max McMahon Oval in Ruthersford to play the tenth-placed Maitland Saints; Wyong Lakes are away to Lake Macquarie knowing they must win and hope that Gosford lose; Gosford, who have a two-game home set to finish the Home & Away season, host Killarney Vale knowing that victory books them a place in the Finals Series; Singleton, playing their last game of the Home & Away season before a last round Bye, host Nelson Bay at Rose Point Park, and in a mouth-watering possible dress rehearsal for the Grand Final, second-placed Cardiff host Terrigal Avoca at Hillsborough in the BARTV Match of the Week. In a fascinating fixture at Hillsborough, the Minor Premiership (and the priceless week off) is up for grabs as Terrigal Avoca head up the M1 to take on their rivals from the truly outstanding 2017 Grand Final, the Cardiff Hawks. The Panthers are well-structured, have a large midfield rotation, a suffocating back six and the rapidly-improving tap ruckman Jasper Davis feeding prime movers Chris Bishop and James Webster. Brandon Thomas is over some niggling injuries, with an electrifying eight-goal haul against Nelson Bay last week. Of interest will be who marks up on Hawks forwards Lachlan Price, Jack Lennon, Cam Jones and Tom Yensch when he goes forward. Corbin Bond may get Price, with Jarrad Flint a possible match-up for the burly Jones. Yensch may have company from Jayson Van Dam when he ventures into the forward 50. Hawks coach Nathan Harkness has some interesting decisions of his own. With an attack-minded followers group featuring Lennon, Simon O'Brien and Marcus DeLeur, Harkness may elect not to tag Bishop and/or Webster. Matt Vukovich looms as a possible tagger for Bishop, given their similar height. Cardiff like to free up Nick Tomlinson and Zac Metcalfe in their back six, so it would not surprise to see Bishop have Thomas or possibly Mark Skuse line up on Tomlinson and take him to the goalsquare. Pete Van Dam can run all day and he might end up on Metcalfe, again making Metcalfe work defensively all day in a bid to nullify the Hawks key rebound man across half back. In a massive fixture at Adcock Park, Gosford must win to secure their place in the Finals series, it really is as simple as that. The Tigers have struggled in recent weeks, despite the return of key backman Scott Burkinshaw. Missing small forward Adam Lyons, the Tigers need big performances from Patrick Murphy, coach Josh Barty, Tristan Carter and full-forward Tim Eather if they are to defeat the Bombers. Killarney Vale will be sweating on the progress of injured star trio Brendan Lewis, Josh Mifsud and League ruckman Tim Oosterhoff as they prepare for an important game. The Bombers can finish anywhere from fifth to seventh in the Top 7, and they will need all hands on deck if they are defeat a desperate Tigers outfit this week. Lachlan Waters, coach Scott Reed, Ben Simpson and Dan Cartwright will have to be at their best if the Bombers are to hold onto sixth place. Warners Bay, seemingly entrenched in fourth spot and looking directly at a sudden-death week one semi-final against the Singleton Roosters, are looking to fine-tune their midfield and forward line against the Saints before a massive last round clash against fierce rivals Cardiff at Hillsborough. Both Jack Hardman and Jake Roach, who have had interrupted seasons, will play as long as possible on the hard and fast MCG-sized Max McMahon Oval. With No.1 rover Matt Spinks picking up a slight injury last week, it is unlikely he will be risked before the semi-finals. Coach Marty Reiman has some interesting selection issues this week, with Josh Nicol, Kayne Gibbs and David McGuinness all pressing for a return to Black Diamond Cup duties. Maitland will look to finish a very tough season on a high note in their last two games. The Saints have been served well season by Chris Pedler, veteran ruckman Mick Norton, Mitchell Greaves and in the back half of the season by their star player Patrick McMahon. Wyong Lakes, after the Bye last week, are still in the hunt for a finals berth after Gosford stumbled in Singleton last Saturday. The Magpies are expected to win at Tulkaba Park against the last-placed Lake Macquarie, then they are completely dependent on an injury-ravaged Killarney Vale defeat Gosford at Adcock Park. Those two results would set up an epic last round encounter, when Gosford host the Magpies. Brayden Tos, Lee Moore, Peter Drzal and fullback have been the Magpies best players this season and they must extract another good performance by their teammates this week. Lake Macquarie can see the end of the season just around the corner, where they can sit back and begin early preparations for a much-improved 2019. Olive Bunny, Riley Janissen, fullback Damian McIntyre and talented youngster Damon Tually have been the Dockers best players in a disappointing season for the Tulkaba Park faithful. Nelson Bay, finalists in the past two seasons but most disappointing this year, make the trek to Rose Point Park to take on a confident, finals-bound Singleton. The Marlins, humbled by first-placed Terrigal Avoca last week, must find an avenue to goal this week against a Singleton side who don't kick large scores, instead relying on solid defensive structures. Billy Barton and Joel Erickson have show their maturity and consistency all season, and star player Jayden Rymer, hampered by injury at times this year, has again shown he is one of the class players in the League. Singleton have welcomed the return from injury of Mitchell Gaffney (broken jaw) and will look to Gaffney, Alex Mitchell and Travis Bates to kick them a winning score this week. Apart from the star duo of Sam Brasington and Andrew Scott, the Roosters have had consistent seasons from Oliver Moody, Roosterettes coach Andrew MacPherson and Luke Davis as they head toward the finals after the Bye next week. Newcastle City has the Bye in the lead-up to their huge last home game of the season on August 4; hosting Terrigal Avoca.
