APPLICATION DIRECTOR OF COACHING



OVERVIEW

Applications are requested for Director of Coaching - Marcellin Eagles Basketball Club. The role has two primary focus areas:

- 1. Development of Coaches
- 2. Primary School Programs

DEVELOPMENT OF COACHES

The primary duties of the role include the following:

- Develop coaches to improve their skills and knowledge.
- Provide support for coaches such as training and manuals to assist with new drills and coaching techniques etc.
- Ensure all coaching documentation is available and kept up to date on the MEBC website or other relevant forum
- Proactively identify and organise coaching clinics and communicate with potential participants.
- Liaise with Team Co-ordinators to determine coaches performance e.g. to identify and provide support if required, mentor younger coaches, etc.
- Liaise closely with Team Co-ordinators during the season to determine future coach requirements.
- Proactively contact current and prospective coaches for next season recruitment.

PRIMARY SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The second core objective is based on building player and team numbers.

During 2018 the Club has commenced running clinics at a number of primary schools. The Club remains open to various strategies, however would like to focus on continuing to build relationships with these schools, and expand this program to include additional primary schools in the local area.

This would include developing an "offer" to market to schools, to proactively approach, seek interest, organize and run related programs.

HOURS & ACTIVITY

Training is conducted on Monday & Thursday nights from 5-9pm, and all games are played on a Saturday. All training sessions and home games are located at Marcellin College, 160 Bulleen Road, Bulleen.

Attendance throughout both training nights and on average 4 games per week would be expected.

Organising additional activities such as school holiday clinics, coaches meetings, and coaches courses, including preparation time is within scope.

Hours have been allowed to both canvas primary schools, and to establish and run a number of primary school clinics.

The role of Director of Coaching includes being a member of the Marcellin Eagles Committee on a voluntary basis. Typically there are 5 meetings per annum, and a status report would be required to detail activity and progress against each objective. Meetings are usually held on a Sunday night.

RELATIONSHIP & PAYMENT

This will not be an employer/employee relationship. The successful applicant will already have, or obtain an ABN and invoice MEBC as a third party supplier. It is anticipated that services would be invoiced on a monthly basis.

The proposed rate would be \$33 per hour, this would include superannuation, GST, and any other related employment oncosts. The annual budget for Director of Coaching is 600 hours equating to \$20,000 per annum.

The potential to conduct individual or small group player development sessions is possible, and would be an extra activity beyond the initial scope considered, therefore potential income in addition to the above.

ATTRIBUTES & EXPERIENCE

- Strong basketball experience either playing and/or coaching
- An energetic person who can both work independently and liaise with all parties competently and effectively
- Demonstrates initiative and is proactive
- Methodical and organized
- An ability to liaise and work with people across a wide spectrum of ages
- The successful applicant will need to provide or obtain a Working with Children Check.

*In relation to point C – hours of availability; training nights on Monday & Thursday with games on Saturday has been mentioned, however the key purpose is to understand any restrictions around these hours, and also an indication of availability in being able to deliver, and/or organize for other coaches to deliver School Programs.

APPENNDIX - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

CLUB OVERVIEW

The Marcellin Eagles Basketball Club (MEBC) is a family orientated basketball club located at Marcellin College, a leading Catholic secondary boys' school.

The Club was established in the 1950's and was first registered as an Incorporated Association in 1992 and trades by the name Marcellin Eagles Basketball Club. The Club complies with the legislative requirements of the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 and the Associations Incorporation Reform Regulations 2012.

TEAMS

The MEBC now averages 30-32 teams per season with over 250 registered players in all age groups for both boys and girls. It participates with 16 other member clubs of the Eastern Districts Junior Basketball Association.

REPRESENTATIVE BASKETBALL

Marcellin Eagles Basketball Club does not have a preferred affiliation with any VJBL representative basketball club. Currently there is a wide range of clubs where existing players choose to play within this competition.

COACHES

To provide a guide with regards to the existing coaches, they would broadly fall within the following categories:

Recruitment of coach's is a common challenge and the Director of Coaching would be expected to assist in reaching out and helping to find and recruit new coaches each season. One of the core strategic objectives is to create a development program to help attract and retain Coaches providing a development pathway.

COMPETITION

The Eastern Districts Junior Basketball Association (EDJBA) is one of the largest domestic junior basketball competitions in Australia, with approximately 1,200 teams and over 10,000 participants. The Association prides itself on providing an exceptional basketball competition, suitable for all playing abilities. Its focus is on participation in a safe and enjoyable environment.

The Association has 16 member clubs, one of which is the Marcellin Eagles Basketball Club. Each club varies in size, location and philosophy, with clubs spread from Eltham to Nunawading and Park Orchards to Collingwood. MEBC is one of the Association's smaller club members and is run by a committee of volunteers.

The EDJBA accommodates both boys and girls teams in age groups ranging from under 8 to under 20. Due to the size of the competition, the Association caters for the varying grades and abilities of teams.

Each year consists of two seasons, winter and summer. Winter season commences from April to September (excluding school holidays). Teams are comprised of players who are under the age of 9, 11, 13, 15, 17 and 19 on the 1st January before the season commences.

Summer season commences from October to March (excluding school holidays). Teams are comprised of players who are under the age of 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18 and 20 years on 1st July before the season commences.
