



# A man loved by all

**Long-time Calder Cannons trainer and Hall of Fame member Phil Dunk made an impact on the lives of everyone who has passed through the club in his 21 years of service there.**

Dunk was 69 years of age when he passed away on May the 2nd this year, shortly after the Cannons faced the Murray Bushrangers in Round 6 of the TAC Cup.

Calder Talent Manager Ian Kyte paid tribute to the man who was a part of the TAC Cup since its inaugural season of 1992, spending three years at the Western Jets before joining the Cannons when they entered the competition in 1995.

"Phil had the ability to talk to everybody and know something about them to talk to them about, and that made you think you were the only person he spoke to like that," Kyte said.

"He never missed saying hello to anybody or talking to them about something personal, not just about footy.

"He built up a pretty intimate knowledge of nearly everybody at the club."

Kyte said Dunk did most of his talking from his chair in the Calder trainers' room, which has since become a memorial with a photo of Dunk displayed above it.

In fact, hours before he passed away, Kyte tells of how Dunk was sitting on that very chair watching another squad of young Cannons run past him onto the playing field.

"It was really interesting – he was sitting in his chair near the door as the boys were going out and our conditioning guy said to them, 'Don't forget to give Phil a pat on the head as you go past', and every boy who ran out to play that day gave Phil a tap on the back or rubbed his head as they were heading out," Kyte said.

“It was a fairly fitting farewell.”

Kyte said it was testament to Dunk’s impact on 24 years’ worth of TAC Cup players that so many of them who went on to become AFL stars attended his funeral.

Among them was Richmond ruckman Ivan Maric, who said the humbling experience made him think about whether he truly appreciated the impact Dunk’s qualities had on the club while he was alive.

But Maric knows he’ll be seeing evidence of them for years to come.

“Maybe those qualities have passed on through a lot of players,” he said.

“That’s what happens in families – those behaviours get passed on, and they’ll definitely stay within the Calder Cannons Football Club and all the Calder Cannons families.”

Maric said Dunk was someone who made him feel truly welcome in a new world of elite underage football.

“(At first,) I didn’t really know anyone in the football world, but he knew my name and knew how to say it properly,” Maric recalled.

“Then, even when I left and went to Adelaide, he’d still text me and ask me how I was going.

“I went back and did some coaching there in the last

couple of years, and he was still there – nothing had really changed. He was always asking everyone how they were going, making sure they were alright.”

A more recent Cannon to have been impacted by Dunk is Gold Coast half-back Adam Saad, who said his enduring memories of the man who so often taped him up was simply having a laugh together.

“As soon as I’d walk in (to the club), he’d always say: ‘Adam, you’ve gotta shave the beard,’” Saad recalled.

“He was always the one at the club who you could just go to and speak about things other than footy.

“He was actually one of a kind.”

Ian Kyte said Dunk would be sorely missed by everyone he came into contact with, including the Calder medical staff who would revel in dragging Dunk onto the ground at training to walk laps of the oval with them.

“It was interesting recently – one of our physios got a little bit upset when he walked into the trainer’s room,” Kyte recalled.

“His parting gesture would be to yell at Phil and say, ‘Have you walked your laps yet, you lazy so-and-so?’ and Phil would have a go back at him, but our physio walked into the room (that day) and said, ‘He’s not here... Who am I going to yell at?’

“It’s those things (we’ll miss); while he’s gone, it’s going to be a long time before he’s forgotten.”

# Magner burning to return for the Borough

**James Magner had missed one game of football through injury in 10 years before hurting his right wrist tendon while playing for Port Melbourne in Round 3 of the Peter Jackson VFL season.**

As Round 10 rolls around, the ex-Melbourne AFL player is now set for another 10-12 weeks on the sidelines after recently undergoing surgery on the wrist (which wasn't healing naturally) and is hating seeing his teammates take the field without him.

But he may not have always felt that way.

Following his delisting from the Demons at the end of the 2013 season, the 27-year-old Magner found himself feeling slightly bitter about the way his time at the top level ended.

It affected the start to his fourth life as a VFL player at North Port Oval in 2014, after stints with Frankston (2007-09), Sandringham (2010-11) and Casey (during his time with Melbourne in 2012-13).

"I lacked a little bit of motivation initially," Magner said of his drop back to the VFL.

He was still physically capable of playing the tough in-and-under brand of footy he has become renowned for over 121 VFL games, but mentally, Magner needed a freshen-up.

Of all people, it was his grandma who provided it in late June last year.

"I went to Ireland for my grandma's 80th birthday and it sort of refreshed me mentally," Magner said.

"I didn't really think about football during the trip because I spent a lot of time with family and I hadn't seen them in so long, so I essentially forgot about football for two or three weeks.

"Coming back, I realized how much I did miss football and how much I enjoyed it."

Magner truly hit his straps upon his return to Australia, being named in Port Melbourne's best players in seven of the Borough's last nine home-and-away games and playing an instrumental part in the club's top-placed finish and run to a preliminary final.

But after last season's high of falling back in love with footy, for now Magner has to watch as seventh-placed Port Melbourne (5-3) attempts to make it into yet another finals series.



Having now lost their last two matches to the Box Hill Hawks and Sandringham, his teammates at the Borough would probably want James Magner to return to the field as much as he wants to be out there himself.

# Rebel Tucker ticking the boxes

**Captaincy is sitting rather well with Darcy Tucker at the moment.**

The North Ballarat Rebels skipper has seized his opportunity to lead one of the most talented lists in the TAC Cup, a team currently sitting on top of the ladder after ten rounds.

In a unique situation with so many of its players coming from so many different places – including interstate – North Ballarat might have been in danger of lacking the cohesiveness required to be a successful team.

But in a key event for the club's barnstorming start to 2015, 18-year-old Tucker and the Rebels' leadership group helped make sure everyone was on the same page at a pre-season camp.

"That weekend really helped the boys get together," Tucker said.

"We all bonded very well and got to know each other a lot more, because in our region there are boys (living) two or three hours away who have never met half the team before.

"As top-age players, we all helped the bottom-agers and new people, and we bonded very quickly."

Tucker said his approach to the captaincy was to "lead by example" through his actions on the field and his professionalism off it.

"I try to tick all the boxes," Tucker said, in a sign he already has the footy leadership lingo down pat.

Tucker ticked plenty of boxes in his bottom-age 2014 season, earning All Australian selection after a stellar NAB AFL U18 Championships as a damaging half-back for Vic Country.

After overcoming an ankle injury that wiped out much of the second half of his 2014 season, Tucker has started the new year by moving into a role in North Ballarat's midfield.

He often played as a midfielder in his junior days with the Horsham Saints, but Tucker said his form has been "up-and-down" as he adjusts to the role at TAC Cup level.

"I enjoy it, but I've still got a lot to learn," Tucker said.

"I won't be able to dominate straight away in the midfield but I'm willing to learn as much as I can and hopefully become a good player in there as well.

"I've got to add more strings to my bow."

Tucker said right now he feels more comfortable running



off half-back in the mould of Hawthorn's Grant Birchall or North Melbourne's Shaun Atley, AFL players whose ability to run-and-carry he looks up to.

But by adding versatility to his game, Tucker hopes he'll be able to fit in wherever he's required if he's drafted by an AFL club at the end of the year.

It's another case of Darcy Tucker ticking the boxes.

**Thrilling finishes galore on super Saturday**

**It was a heart-stopping weekend for supporters of six Peter Jackson VFL clubs in Round 9, as Geelong, Sandringham and the Casey Scorpions all claimed wins that were in the balance in the final minutes of play.**

In a battle of two desperate two-win teams at Simonds Stadium, the Geelong Cats clawed their way to victory over a gallant North Ballarat outfit by nine points.

Having trailed since the first quarter, the Cats went three goals down to the Roosters shortly after the three-quarter time break before finally putting their noses in front through a Sam Bleasdale set-shot goal with just minutes left on the clock. Daniel Gibbs kicked the sealer soon after to cap off a memorable fighting triumph.

Meanwhile, Coburg surrendered a one-point lead at the last change to lose to the Casey Scorpions away from home at Casey Fields. It was goal-for-goal throughout the final term until Chris Dawes booted the goal that put the Scorpions ahead decisively and ensured their place in the top eight for this week with a record of 5-3.

The third thriller on a mad Saturday afternoon was the result of some high-quality football between Port Melbourne and Sandringham at North Port Oval. There were barely a couple of goals between the teams for the whole match until majors from Mitch Brown and then Eli Templeton sealed the seven-point result in the dying stages for the Zebras, who joined four other teams at the top of the VFL ladder with six wins.

### Two battles for top spot



## Wallace makes AFL debut

The short but rapid rise to the AFL of former Peter Jackson VFL and TAC Cup player Brent Wallace was completed on the weekend.

But it was not the AFL debut he may have dreamt of when progressing through the talent pathway with the Northern Knights and Box Hill Hawks as a player.

Wallace debuted as an AFL field umpire at Etihad Stadium in the clash between St Kilda and Melbourne last weekend, a successful product of the AFL player-to-umpire pathway program.

A combination of illness and injury curbed his senior game time at the Box Hill Hawks and at the end of 2011, Wallace decided he would take up umpiring.

The 23-year-old son of Hawthorn triple premiership player Terry Wallace, Brent started his umpiring journey with the Eastern Football League in 2012 before spending the last two seasons in the VFL, culminating with the 2014 VFL Grand Final.

AFL Victoria's State League Umpiring Head Coach Cameron Nash said it was a good reward for all the hard work that Wallace has put in.

"Since taking up umpiring he has really applied himself in all areas and is very coachable hence his quick rise to the top," Nash said.

"He umpired the VFL Grand Final last year due to his consistent season and finished ranked in our top 3 umpires.

"He has reached the AFL purely on his umpiring ability."

In the lead up to his first game, Brent was looking forward to the next stage of his umpiring journey.

"I am really honoured to be given the opportunity to officiate my first game," Wallace said.

"It has been a fast-track system that I have come through, but at each level I've been given a lot of opportunity and I have stepped up with those opportunities.

"I felt like I was in form and was feeling good about my umpiring, so it was just a matter of waiting for the opportunity and I am glad it arrived.

"Hopefully now I can step up to the top level."

## 2015 Laguntas Program kicks off

**AFL Victoria's Laguntas Program continues to go from strength to strength in the push to provide opportunities for young indigenous footballers.**

The 2015 Laguntas Program kicked off last weekend with a new batch of emerging stars eager to begin a curriculum that centres not just on developing their football skills but also their personal attributes.

The first camp of the season began on Friday at the Korin Gamadji Institute (based at the home of the Richmond Football Club) and provided the new squad with a chance to get to know one another and begin both the on-field and off-field curriculums.

AFL Victoria's Indigenous Programs Manager Aaron Clark said the focus of the program remained on helping indigenous youngsters make the most of their football ability and to ensure they have the opportunity to thrive in the mainstream talent pathway.

So far this has proved to be overwhelmingly successful.

The number of indigenous players in the TAC Cup is significantly higher thanks to programs such as Laguntas (U18) and Kickstart (U15), with 17 boys who have been part of the Laguntas Program over the past few years now on a TAC Cup list.

Triple Brisbane Lions premiership player Chris Johnson returns to be head coach of Laguntas in 2015 and, along with assistants Ricky Coburn and Daniel

Charles, is charged with developing the squad's on-field skills and knowledge of what's needed to reach the highest level.

In partnership with the Korin Gamadji Institute and YMCA, 30 boys from across the state attended the first camp eager to begin a well-trodden football journey.

Over the course of four days, the boys faced fitness testing similar to that conducted at the National Combine and also undertook education sessions on pre-game nutrition and healthy eating in general.

The camp also involved a number of cultural activities including boomerang throwing and listening to traditional indigenous music with Ron Murray.

A visit by Melbourne Football Club's Neville Jetta was another highlight, with the emerging star speaking to the group about his own journey and the importance of having strong team and personal values.

The Pioneers trailed at every change (including by 17 points at half time and by seven at three-quarter time) but put their noses in front when it mattered for a memorable three-point win.

Two other country teams, the Dandenong Stingrays and Gippsland Power, engaged in a high-scoring duel at Shepley Oval that ended in Dandenong claiming a 21-point victory and second position on the ladder, while the Geelong Falcons played out a draw with Tasmania at Avalon Airport Oval to move ahead of Murray into third spot.

Tasmania ended its involvement in the 2015 TAC Cup undefeated with three wins and a draw, while Northern Territory completed its campaign with one win and one loss after accounting for the Northern Knights by 11 points in Darwin on Saturday.

In other matches, Queensland defeated the Calder Cannons by 27 points, the Oakleigh Chargers ran over the Sandringham Dragons by 16 points and the Eastern Ranges did it comfortably against the Western Jets by 32 points.



**Vic Country just about wrapped up the Division 1 crown during Round 4 of the NAB AFL U18 Championships last weekend by defeating South Australia, while Vic Metro broke its 2015 duck with a win over Western Australia.**

# Long time between wins for Vic Country against SA

**With Vic Country ending a huge hoodoo at the NAB AFL U18 Championships on Sunday by defeating South Australia for the first time in 10 meetings, it's worth looking back on the last Country team to have knocked off the Croweaters – way back in 2006.**

Country prevailed by 31 points on that day at Simonds Stadium, led by a three-goal performance from former North Ballarat Rebel and now West Coast player Mitch Brown. The key-position player was taken by the Eagles with pick no.16 in the AFL Draft later that year and has since played 90 AFL games.

Brown's twin brother and North Ballarat teammate Nathan was named in the 2006 U18 All Australian team at full back, also being drafted at the end of the season with Collingwood's pick no.10 in the Draft. He has gone on to play 104 games at the top level including the Magpies' 2010 premiership success.

Current North Melbourne defender Lachlan Hansen was also a part of the Country team, the former Gippsland Power player earning All Australian selection at centre-half back before being taken with pick no.3 in the 2006 Draft and playing 123 games for the Kangaroos.

Others to star that day included:

- Ex-Murray Bushranger Jarrod Harbrow, who booted three goals against SA and was later picked by the Western Bulldogs at no.27 in the AFL Rookie Draft, before moving to the Gold Coast Suns in 2011 (157 AFL games);
- Former North Ballarat Rebel Shaun Grigg, who was named on the wing in the U18 All Australian team and was drafted by Carlton at pick no.19 in the AFL Draft before shifting to Richmond in 2011 (134 AFL games);
- Another past North Ballarat Rebel, current Hawthorn key defender James Frawley, who was initially taken by Melbourne at pick no.12 in the AFL Draft (145 AFL games);
- Ex-St Kilda player Robert Eddy, who played in the 2010 Grand Finals for the Saints after being picked in the 2006 Rookie Draft at no.39 from the Gippsland Power on the back of an All Australian U18 campaign (33 AFL games); and
- Gippsland's Ben Ross, who became a North Melbourne player when the Kangaroos took the midfielder at pick

no.7 in the 2006 Pre-Season Draft (18 AFL games with North Melbourne and Hawthorn).

Vic Country ended up finishing second on the Division 1 U18 Championships table behind the undefeated Vic Metro side, who beat Country in wet conditions in the final game of the Championships.

Metro's team featured several current AFL players such as Geelong's Tom Hawkins (from the Sandringham Dragons), Port Adelaide's Robbie Gray (Oakleigh Chargers), North Melbourne's Leigh Adams (Eastern Ranges) and Carlton's Matthew Kreuzer (Northern Knights) and Andrejs Everitt (Dandenong Stingrays).
