Louis is 17 years old and is a highly accomplished athlete across three sports, Water Polo, Surf Lifesaving and Swimming.

Louis has played in all Canterbury Water Polo Representative teams since taking up the sport. He has represented Under 16, under 18, under 20, and Senior Men.

He represented Canterbury Under 18 and Under 20 Men's teams at the Pan Pacific Youth Water Polo Festival held in Auckland in July 2018. He will also represent Canterbury Under 18 team at the National Championships later this month in Auckland.

At the 2017 Canterbury Water Polo Awards he was named as Age Group player of the year and Under 16 MVP.

He was selected for the New Zealand Men's youth team that competed at the FINA World Youth Championships in Hungary in August this year.

In Surf Lifesaving Louis won gold in the Men's Open Surf Race and silver and bronze in other events at The NZ National Championships.

He was selected in the New Zealand Team that competed in Fukuoka, Japan at the Sanyo Cup against top international competition and won the surf race and tube rescue and was second in the surf teams race and ocean relay.

In swimming, he won gold at the NZ Age Group Swimming Championships, silver in the 400 metre Freestyle and 200m individual medley in the 16 year old age group in 2018.

He is an extremely promising athlete and Hellers and Canterbury Sports Foundation are proud to assist him in his sporting career.
