# HILL TOP UNDER 15'S DOMINATE ST PAULS STORMING TO 3-0 GRAND FINAL VICTORY



In one of their most polished performances of the season, Hill Top Under 15's totally outgunned the 2018 U15 minor premiers St Pauls, clinically putting away the boys in Blue 3-0 to kick off grand final day in the best possible way for the Hill Top Soccer club.

A tight first 20 minutes was punctuated by a great strike by Jeremy Davis, who put the U15s up 1-0 after some great lead-up work by Calum Fraser. The Under 15's defensive line was particularly strong on grand final day, with Finn Malone, Nicholas Speakman and Luke Johnson all frustrating the St Paul's attack, in not giving them the slightest of openings. The defensive job Bodhie Neal did on St Pauls dangerman Sam Maurice was also a telling factor, defusing the season's leading goal-scorer to such an extent, the St Pauls coach extraordinarily moved him into the role of goalkeeper for the second half.

The Kookaburra's 2nd half got off the best possible start, with Finn Malone continuing his outstanding goal-scoring run, slamming a lovely volley across the St Pauls Keeper to register the U15s second goal. Mid-way through the second half Calum Fraser threaded a beautiful ball through to put Finn Malone in for his second, giving the U15s an unassailable 3-0 lead. The U15s maintained their dominance through to full time.

As a team the U15s were near faultless on their biggest day, with grand Final MVP Finn Malone, Dylan Ruiters, and Bodhie Neal all stand-outs, as well as Goalkeeper David Napper, who recorded a clean sheet against the most potent attacking team in 2018.

The win capped off a great season for the Hill Top U15s, who took out the Under 15 Jan Plain Cup midway through the season to record a rare Grand Final/Cup double.

### HILL TOP YOUTH DEFEAT CHEVALLIER COLLEGE TO TAKE OUT GRAND FINAL IN EXTRA TIME



Capping off what was the near perfect season, Hill Top Youth team defeated Chevallier College 1-0 in the 2018 Youth decider, in a game that went deep into extra time and was decided only a handful of minutes short of heading to a dreaded penalty shoot-out.

Whilst never having dropped a game to Chevallier the entire season, no more than a single goal ever separated the teams whenever they met in 2018, and the grand final was no exception. A very tight first half with limited opportunities saw both teams head into the main break locked at 0-0, with Kookaburra's coach Mark Johnson urging his team to stick to the game-plan and maintain patience at all times.

The second half was much the same as the first, with disciplined defence by both teams meaning the opportunities were extremely limited. After the full 90 minutes the scoreboard remained deadlocked at 0-0.

At the start of the 2nd period of extra-time a communication error between fullbacks Shayne Brown and David Holland almost handed the game to Chevallier, however, a brilliant recovery from goalkeeper Lucas Carpenter saw the 1-on-1 drama averted. No more than 2 minutes after this scare the Kookaburra's broke the stalemate in dramatic circumstances, with Hill Top's 2018 Rookie of the Year, Dylan Errington, cracking home a thunderous strike to put the boys in front after approximately 110 minutes of football.

A tense final 7 minutes saw Chevallier press Hill Top hard, but the Kookaburra's held on to record a thoroughly deserved grand final victory, underlining their crowning three weeks earlier as undefeated Youth Grade minor premiers for season 2018

### HILL TOP AAM BREAK A 15 YEAR GRAND FINAL DROUGHT IN FIRST GRADE CLIFFHANGER



In one of the most gripping Grand Finals in recent history, Hill Top's Premier League men stormed home to overrun Yerrinbool in the First grade decider, wiping away 15 year of disappointment in bringing home the club's third major trophy for the day.

The game did not get off the best start for the Kookaburra's, with Bushranger's Scott Hillard bringing up the grand final's first goal after 15 minutes, despite calls of handball by Hill Top players in the lead-up being ignored by the referee.

After that opening setback, Hill Top slowly began to take control of the contest, creating a number of good first half chances. A superb long-range attempt by Chris Packer cannoned off the crossbar just before the break, with the Kookaburra's heading confidently into half time despite being behind 1-0 on the scoreboard.

As Hill Top's second half confidence continued to grow, Yerrinbool parked the proverbial bus in front of their goals, grimly defending their lead as the Kookaburra's pressed hard for the equalizer. After a number of very close calls, Andy Rae latched onto a great pass from a teammate to thunder the ball into the back of the net, bringing the score level at 1-1 midway through the second half.

With the momentum now well-and-truly behind the Kookaburra's, Hill Top's forward line exerted wave-after-wave of attack towards the Yerrinbool goal, with the Bushrangers finally cracking a second time when Youth Grade substitute player Flynn Hessenberger put away a shot deflected by the Yerrinbool Keeper, sending the Hill Top crowd behind the Boardman Avenue goals into absolute delirium.

It was now Hill Top's turn to hold on for dear life in the final 10 minutes, which they did, rounding out not only a great day the senior men and the club all-round.
