SMOKE FREE POLICY

Our commitment

Our club supports a smoke free environment including passive smoking which is the breathing in of smoke that comes off the end of a burning cigarette, the smoke that is exhaled into the atmosphere by a smoker or vapour from an E-cigarette. This smoke/vapour is referred to as second-hand smoke, passive smoke or environmental tobacco smoke.

The health effects of passive smoking are now well documented. Long-term exposure to second-hand smoke can cause heart disease and lung cancer. Exposure to second-hand smoke can trigger asthma attacks in adults and cause asthma and trigger asthma attacks in children. Respiratory symptoms of passive smoking include sore throat and hoarseness, nasal symptoms, chronic cough and chronic phlegm.

What we will do

Enforce a smoke free environment for players, spectators and visitors through signs and one-to-one interactions

What we ask you to do

All members and sporting personnel are required to comply themselves and point out the requirements of this policy to visitors/family members or seek the assistance of the MPIO
