The founding philosophy; to give any player, volunteer or coach the opportunity to compete and participate at District level, to provide a sporting club, service and facility to any member of the local community with the opportunity to join, be welcomed and actively participate in the great sport of Basketball.

WDBC is currently based at the St Clair Recreation Centre on Woodville Road which has foot traffic of more than 100,000 people per year. We predominantly service the wider western suburbs community, but also service the metropolitan and country areas of South Australia with an approximate total of 300 players at junior and senior level and approximately 100 Life members and many wonderful individual members and volunteers.

WDBC caters for basketball players of all ages and abilities. Starting with beginner "Aussie Hoops" programs introducing Basketball to children aged 5-8 years of age as well as registering teams in Basketball SA district level competitions from Under 10 to Under 23 and Senior age groups. We have the ability to provide elite level pathways to state, national and international level for the Basketball stars of the future. Our elite level players can be seen in action in the Basketball SA Premier League and players at various times can and have represented the club in state teams, at various national tournaments across Australia, in National Teams and in the USA college Basketball system.

THE PREMIER LEAGUE

This is the elite level competition for Men and Women in the State (formally known as the Central Australian Basketball League, CABL). There are 10 member clubs that compete in a season that runs from March to August in 18 rounds plus finals in a home, away and neutral venue format.

The Premier League will include State and National level players as well as International imports and is used as a "feeder" into the National Basketball League and Women's National Basketball League competitions as well as other competitions around the world.

The premier league is widely advertised through Basketball SA media, marketing and communications and is often reported on in several media sources such as the Messenger and Advertiser Newspapers and various Basketball specific online media.
