

CODE OF CONDUCT

Yarragon Football Netball Club Inc



Members, players of both netball and football and the public in general need to be assured that they are in a safe environment whilst competing, socialising and working within the YFNC Inc.

Players, members and the general public need to be reassured that the interest of each individual is valued and respected. We expect that each player, member and person of the general public conducts themselves at a high level of personal behaviour on and off the field so as not to bring the club, or the games of Australian Football and Netball into disrepute.

This means that we will not tolerate:

- Discriminatory behaviour
- Abusive behaviour
- Inappropriate and / or offensive language
- Behaviour not conducive to the best interests of the club
- Excessive alcohol consumption

The club **shall and will evoke strict measures** to ensure this environment is adhered to at all times, including but not limited to:

- Any member, player of the club or public who behaves in a manner, inside the premises or on the grounds which is not acceptable will be asked to leave
- In circumstances where they refuse, they will be escorted off the premises and committee members will decide on the most appropriate course of action
- The management of the club shall at all times adhere to the RSA policy and Good Sports Program. The management shall at all times refuse the service of alcohol to any player, member, or member of the general public **they deem** unfit to consume liquor
- The club shall exercise its right and responsibility to escort persons who are abusive or intoxicated from the premises and, if necessary, call Police to escort persons from the premises.
