Area Permit Agreement for Season 2019

Between Mininera and District Football League and Ararat and District Junior Football Association

This agreement is signed and pursuant to the AFL Vic Country rules and regulations pertaining to clearances and permits and in particular rule 2.10 Area Permits, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the above mentioned leagues may take place without clearance or permits and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

- 1. That this agreement is in place for the 2019 season only.
- 2. That the player(s) involved desire to play with the Mininera DFL of the ADJFA on the day in question.
- 3. That the players concerned are aware of the AFL Vic Country regulations 2.1 and 2.5 regarding permits. The conditions referred to in Rule 2.2 do not apply under this agreement. there is no 8 game restriction under this agreement.
- 4. That prior to player(s) first match with the chosen club, the player(s) must obtain written permission from the club where the he/she is registered.
- 5. The Permit Form signed by the player is valid for the 2019 Season only. The player(s) need to sign one Permit Form, this form to be valid for the 2019 Season.
- 6. The Permit Form must be signed in triplicate, one copy sent to the ADJFA, one copy sent to MDFL and one copy held by the player(s) registered club.
- 7. The player(s) at any time during the season may interchange between the ADJFA and the HDFL back to their registered club.
- 8. Players can only apply for a Permit to play with one club in the 2019 season.
- 9. At all times the player(s) will remain registered with their club of origin for the 2019 season.
- 10. ADJFA registered players should not play ahead or at the expense of other registered MDFL players.
- 11. Permit player(s) must be listed on the team sheet as Area Permit Player(s). failure to do so could see the club penalised under the AFL Vic Country Rule 1.3 (ineligible players)
- 12. Finals qualification will be based on the local finals qualification by-laws for each League/Association.
- 13. All permit players shall be transacted via the AFL Footyweb permit system using the match day permit option with the requested day only specified.
