Ground Official. Matches will not proceed without a ground official. It is not a hard job- The manager will have a copy at games if you would like to re read before your official duty. You are generally over-seeing your game, taking control if a player is injured, controlling the crowd/ parents making sure they are conducting themselves in an appropriate manner. The club committee are always contactable and will help if any situation develops so don't feel under pressure with this job.

Canteen roster – Canteen is the main income for the soccer club throughout the season to pay for end or year trophies etc. Please help out and do your bit with the roster – its only a few times over the season & with many games you are likely to be able to see your child playing from the canteen. Children under 16 y.o are not permitted in the canteen for insurance reasons. If you have little ones to look after try and organise with another team mum or dad to look after each other's children while you take your turn. It is not fair if we do not help out and leave the canteen for 1 or 2 people each week to run while our kids line up to buy!
