The Parrots have been the story of the year so far sitting at two wins after defeating fellow premiership fancies Maffra and Traralgon. The side is still playing undermanned but is showing the

lists depth managing to bring up premiership winning reserves players that haven't looked out of place. Leongatha should win and win comfortably with the Parrots claiming the last six victors over the Power. Wonthaggi cannot let Chris Dunne kick his four or five goals and must lock down James Lloyd. Aiden Lindsay needs help through the middle if they are going to be any chance of victory. For the Parrots they need to hit the scoreboard after only managing 8 goals at Wonthaggi last year.

In week two of the split round Bairnsdale have an excellent opportunity to get on the board in 2019 against Morwell. The Red Leg's sit 0-2 but their performances have been solid with a narrow away loss to Sale and a 26 point loss to Maffra. They appear to be closing the gap but will need to prove that with a big win over the young tigers. Both sides will go in with contrasting motivations. For Bairnsdale at the start of the year they would have penned this in as a must win if they are any chance of finals where the Tigers will go in and have a free shot without a lot of expectation on the road. Interestingly Morwell has won four out of the last five games at Bairnsdale with the Red Legs getting home in a close match last year. Before that they had suffered 8 straight losses to the Tigers who on paper appear to be their bogey side. Shaun Wyatt looks to be back and combined with Nick Sing & Simon Deery provides some top end talent. The midfield battle looks to be where it will be won and lost with Wyatt, McKeon, Cowan and co up against Rosato, Tatterson and Jacobsen. Look out for Brayden McCarrey up forward for Bairnsdale, with no standout experienced defender jumping off Morwell's team list he could be the match winner up forward.

Traralgon make their home debut under lights against the top of the table Lions. The Maroons sit in unfamiliar territory winless after two weeks of football and it isn't a great time to get Moe fresh of two big wins. The Maroons have had a large number of personnel changes and will need to get their midfield firing. For the Lions they smashed Drouin last week who had beaten the Maroon's first up in 2019. Moe's big recruits were on show with Spencer White kicking four and Lachlan McLeod kicking three while Bernie Vince was superb. 2017 league B&F James Blaser should be back after missing last week and gives Moe more firepower through the middle. It's tough to tip against Traralgon at home however Moe mean business in 2019. Traralgon have won 9 out of the last 10 matches against Moe with the Lions sole win coming in 2017 at Traralgon. Can Moe's stars come to play on the TRFM Gippsland League big stage Saturday night under lights?

The final match of the round is perhaps has the most to play for. The first instalment of the Western Derby sees Warragul enter the game winless this year. The Hawks are coming of the highs of a round one win over Traralgon and the lows of a heavy loss last week. The positives for Drouin is that star Eddie Morris is in good form early, expect him and Bob McCallum to have a huge influence on the game. For the first time in recent years the Hawks will go in as favourites. The spectating public can only hope it mirrors last years first match with Drouin holding on for a one point victory. A loss for Warragul could see them in a world of pain with two away matches against Leongatha and Maffra to follow they could be staring down the barrel of a winless first five weeks if they lose this match.

With some surprise winners in round 1, the second week of the TRFM Gippsland League season was billed as proving crucial to several sides 2019 seasons. After a disappointing loss at Drouin the Maroons put in a far better overall performance against last years premiers. On the road again, the Maroons finished with a rush but fell three points short of a season starting victory. The Parrots now sit with two wins and no losses to start the year after their back to back premierships. They are still missing some o their top end talent which serves as a he warning to the competition after two wins over premiership contenders. The little maestro Chris Dunne was back in from kicking 5 while James Lloyd again proved a target up forward with two. Verboon was solid down back with Josh Hopkins starting the season on fire. For the Maroons key forward Dylan Loprese was again among the goals with 3 while Mitch Mustoe and Haydn Hector were among the best.

The Lions have proved a bogey side for Drouin over the past few seasons and it didn't take long for this to be clear that it wasn't changing in 2019. Moe kicking 7 goals to none in the first quarter to all but seal the win. To the Hawks credit they stemmed the flow in the last half with some in accuracy from Moe helping the cause. The Lions would eventually run out 92-point winners and now sit at the top of the table after two weeks. Spencer White kicked 4 while another recruit was the star of the day with Lachlan McLeod kicking three goals and being named the Lions best. Bernie Vince and Mitch Stanlake were also among Moe's better players while for the Hawks Eddie Morris was a standout in the loss.

The Power came to Morwell recreation reserve on a high after their round 1 win but after a five goal to one first quarter it was a reality check. Things didn't really improve throughout the day for Wonthaggi as the young Tigers pulled out a 59-point win. Defender Zach Cantrill kicked two goals for the Tigers who featured 13 gaol kickers on the day while Anthony Rosato was named best. For the Power Patrick Ryan added to his season tally with two goals while young Josh Schultz was named best along with Jordan Staley and Aiden Lindsay.

Sale continued their great start to 2019 with a convincing away win over Warragul. The Magpies had the match sewn up at three guarter time taking in a 45-point lead. A few late goals to the Gulls reduced the margin to 31 pints at the final siren. Tom Hams has returned to the Gippsland League with all guns blazing putting in another best on ground performance. Mitch Dowse and Kane Martin were also among Sale's better players on the day. For the Gull's it has been a tough start to 2019. Matt Rennie got on the board with two goals while Nick Mulgueen was the best with two goals also.

Under lights in Maffra it was the League's two most eastern clubs facing of for bragging rights in East Gippsland. The Eagle's were the hot favourites coming in and managed to get the win but not without some strong competition from the Red Legs. Maffra took an early lead and never relinquished it with a 5.4 34 first term to Bairnsdale's three goals straight. Th margin was 27 at three quarter time and 26 points at the final siren. Kade Renooy was on target for the Eagles with 3 while Andrew Petrou was again among the gaols also kicking three. Arguably the Eagles best two players were named best for the match with Sam Pleming named best on field and Ed Carr second best. Bravden McCarrey continued his great start to 2019 with 4. 2018 AGA Rookie of the Year nominee Cal McKeon was the Red Legs best while VFL star Nick Sing was also solid for Bairnsdale.






