



CDNA DRESS CODE POLICY

CLUB COLOURS & UNIFORMS

1. Each team member shall wear a uniform of the same design and colour.
This may include:
 - a) Skirt, polo shirt or t-shirt and sports briefs
 - b) Netball Dress
 - c) Netball Shorts must not be longer than the skirt or dress.
 - d) All dresses / skirts must be long enough to cover sports briefs/ netball shorts when standing.
2. Gloves, leggings, long sleeved top, tracksuit pants, or shorts are NOT PERMITTED, except on the grounds of medical condition upon receipt of a doctor's certificate signed by a qualified medical practitioner, or religious and cultural reasons upon application to the committee of management in writing. Gloves should be cotton, with no rubber grip on fingers or palm.
3. Any team wishing to adopt a uniform, which varies from the Association's official dress code, is required to submit a design to be approved by the Association Executive Committee.
4. Position patches to be worn by all players - letters to be 20cm high and worn front and back, above the waist of the player.
5. SPONSORSHIP ADVERTISING ON POSITIONAL BIBS IS NOT PERMITTED.
6. When a uniform is considered inappropriate, the player(s) concerned may be ordered to leave the court. NB: A player who is ordered from the court shall not be replaced by another player. When a centre player is ordered from the court, the captain may make one change only from players presently playing on the court until the interval, in respect to providing a centre player.

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
