RULES & SCORING

- Games consist of two **15 minutes** halves. There will be **5 minutes** at half time and **5-10 minutes** between games.
- 1. Each team shall supply a goal and central umpires are supplied by the league.
- 2. There are no boundary umpires. If the ball goes out of bounds by foot, whether on the full or not, a free kick will be awarded to the opposing team. A player CANNOT score directly from this free kick. If the ball goes out of bounds but NOT off a player's foot, a ball up shall occur 5 metres inside the boundary at the point where the ball went out. Normal "out of bounds on the full" and "deliberately out of bounds" rules still apply.
- 3. Team Managers for all teams will be required to report to the recorder upon arrival to confirm attendance, collect all relevant paper work and to submit team sheet.
- 4. Teams named first shall kick to the northern/eastern end.
- 5. At the completion of each game the team managers shall escort the umpires from the oval.
- 6. Team managers shall supply the Recorder with results of matches, etc.
- 7. The point's allocation is as follows:
 - a) 1 points for the winner of each half;
 - b) Half a point if teams have equal scores in a half
 - c) 2 point for the overall winner of the game; and
 - d) In the case of a tie in points, the team with the better percentage becomes the premier.
- 8. Match Balls: Under 14 division use size 4 match balls. Match balls will be supplied by the league.
- 9. Order off Rule: As per AFL Victoria Country rules.
- 10. Blood Rule: It is preferable that umpires don't stop play and we ask clubs to replace players affected by the blood rule as soon as possible without interrupting the game.
- 11. Teams are to play 18 per side and no more than 6 interchange players.
- 12. Each team is allowed 2 water carriers. They are to deliver water after a goal has been scored or when the ball is at the other end of the ground, they are not to coach or deliver messages from the coach.
- 13. Runners are to be correctly attired wearing a high visible jacket and must deliver messages to the player from the coach as quickly as possible. They should not be on the ground for long periods of time and must not interfere with any players or officials.
- 14. Trophies and medallions for the winner of each division will be presented at the league Presentation Night.
- 15. Entry is \$5 per adult.
- 16. Hot and cold food and beverages are available at the canteens throughout the day.

APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2018 WORKSAFE CLUB SAFETY FUND ARE NOW OPEN!

The WorkSafe Club Safety Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to football/netball clubs to make improvements to the safety of their grounds or provide added safety for both players, people involved with the club and the spectators.

Club Safety Fund

Aim: The WorkSafe Club Safety Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to football/netball clubs to make improvements to the safety of their grounds or provide added safety for both players, people involved with the club and the spectators. The 2018 WorkSafe Club Safety Fund will open from June 1 – October 7 (unless funds are exhausted prior to this date).

Objective: The objective of the WorkSafe Club Safety Fund is to provide financial support at a local level to assist with occupational health and safety initiatives at a club level.

Who Can Apply?

- Football Clubs affiliated with WorkSafe AFL Victoria Country (as listed in the AFL Vic Handbook 2018)

How Much Are the Grants?

- The WorkSafe Club Safety Fund provide grants to the value of 50% of the total quoted amount.
- The remaining 50% contribution can be a combination of club/sponsor/council contributions.
- The maximum funding amount is \$2,000 per application.
- Funds will be dispersed upon approval by WorkSafe AFL Victoria Country.
- Please note: Special consideration may be made (at the discretion of WorkSafe AFL Victoria Country) to projects requiring additional financial support. Please make this known via the online application form.

Eligibility:

- All clubs applying, must provide evidence that a grant is needed to improve the safety of their grounds and surrounding buildings.
- Clubs must show that they have the appropriate WorkSafe signage around the club and that there is an Occupational Health and Safety or Risk Management Program being implemented.
- Quotes will be necessary in order to assess the amount of money needed for the improvements.

Funding Categories

- Funding is available for safety initiatives including, but not limited to:
- Equipment to be purchased by the Club that has the purpose of protecting the individual participants while actively engaged in the sport. (i.e. goal post padding, first aid kits, defibrillators)
- Permanent or portable structures that provide shelter and or safety. (i.e. behind goal netting, shelter shed, shade sails, fireplace guards, fencing for walkways)
- Minor facility maintenance which presents an occupational health and safety hazard.

How to Apply

- Applications must be submitted via https://aflvic.smartygrants.com.au/WorkSafeCSF_Rd2
- Copies of all relevant documentation must be attached when submitting your application.
- Approved projects must be completed within the current funding period.
- WorkSafe AFL Victoria Country staff may be contacted for advice when preparing project outline.
