SGL	<p><u>White Ribbon Round</u> Port Pirie on Friday 24th May 2019 and Port Augusta on Sunday 26th May 2019 U18s and U15s on Saturday 25th May 2019, in Port Pirie, with slightly later delay (circa 45 mins) than normal, in match commencement. Concerns were raised about the organisation of the proposed 'Ladies Night' at Memorial Oval on Friday night. PACC has offered a total of \$5000. A cost analysis has revealed a \$400 profit estimate. PA clubs are proposing incentives to build crowd numbers, eg Scoreboard sponsor advertising.
