over Sale. Morwell sit in sixth place but are still three matches out of the five. Needless to say, the Tigers will go in with some hope after their round 4 win over the Eagles. You wouldn't expect this one to go the same way with the Eagles a much better side at home. The best defence in the League against an attack that has struggled to kick goals all year. Morwell will need to find an avenue to goal in order to win this one but there are no clear standouts with a heavy reliance on goals from the midfield. Maffra's star-studded midfield are just starting to find form with their major players all registering over 20 disposals against the Magpies. You can't see Maffra dropping two games to the Tigers in one season, especially when a loss could see their rivals Sale sure up the minor premiership. Weather permitting expect the Eagles to win convincingly.

The Power are in the middle of another tough season. Their depth is being tested after a good start to the year and with a top three side in Moe making the journey to South Gippsland the assignments don't get any easier. The major positive for the Power is the home ground and the games there between the two have been competitive during this era of strength from the Lions. Moe has a good balance of players but still rely on their best players heavily, something they will need to address come finals. The Power could exploit this by shutting the likes of Farrell, Blaser, Wood and Long down they maybe able to make inroads.

Moe have won the last five against Wonthaggi and with Leongatha starting to get players back and find form they cannot afford to drop games against bottom five opponents coming into the finals. Moe to win by anywhere from 3-6 goals on form but being at home gives the Power a chance.

Sale make the trip to Traralgon for the final match of the round. The two teams have very different journeys to finish off season 2019 with Sale sitting at the top of the table and Traralgon unable to make finals with just three wins this year. Sale have a game in hand on Maffra and need to keep winning to stay on top. Traralgon is always a danger game especially at home, but their line-up is very different from previous seasons. Sale will take heart from their loss last week being well in the game against Maffra up until the end. They have been the form side this year and have kicked the most points for the season averaging 92 points per match. Traralgon in contracts have only averaged 57 points per match which sits them at eight in the competition.

Sale should win and win well depending on the conditions. Traralgon have been getting plenty of the football but are unable to get regular deep entries inside 50. The match earlier this year Sale won 92 to 42 which is similar to their average scores for the year. This looks about the gap between the two sides if Sale play to their full potential. The Maroons will be better at home and their best chance is to start well and stay in the game for as long as possible.

The second instalment of the Battle of the Birds for 2019 saw Maffra keep their minor premiership hopes alive. It looks unlikely to be the last time these two teams meet in season 2019 with a final between the arch rivals seeming a formality. Maffra have now won the two meetings this season handing the Magpies their only two losses in 2019. It was tough conditions for both sides and it reflected in the scoring with only 64 points scored for the game between the two sides. Maffra made the most of the early conditions and kicked three first quarter goals which effectively setup the win. Sale managed to move the ball forward enough occasions, but the Maffra defence repelled the majority of their 57 inside 50's. Michael Coleman and Winston Gieschen were the main avenues out of defence with the two bringing the ball out a combined 17 times. Sale simply couldn't mark the ball inside 50 with only two marks for the entire match not assisting their goal tally. Jack Lipman was superb for the Magpies and looks like he could again challenge in the Trood Award and Rodda Medal. He finished with 69 hit outs to go with his 16 disposals returning 160 ranking points for his efforts.

Maffra had winners all over the park and it reflected in the stats with Ed Carr and Michael Coleman both finishing with a game high 29 disposals. Hudson Holmes (28), Alex Carr (24), Jack Johnstone (24) and Danny Butcher (20) all finished above 20 disposals for the game. Ed Carr revelled in the conditions with the hard nosed mid fielder recorded a game high 10 contested possessions along with six clearances. Carr showed he was an umpire favourite last year finishing second in the League B&F and you could almost pencil in a few votes for the former Williamstown star. Mitch Bennett was guite but finished with two goals for the game, he was the only player on the ground to take multiple marks inside 50. Sale handover top place to Maffra on percentage but still have a game in hand to play after the Eagles round 15 clash against the Power was moved forward. The Magpies still hold the edge in the battle for the week off in finals however this loss means they can't afford another slip up.


