

- ▶ The Paddle powers the canoe to move forward






▶ Paddles

- Three colours of our Solomon Island Flag- the paddle contains the 5 stars from the Flag- the 5 main islands of SI
- Three paddles to represent Melanesians/Polynesians and Micronesians
- Three paddles to represent challenge/celebrate and unite
- Three paddles cross over each at the top to symbolize the uniting of peoples
- Three Paddles working together in the water means all our people working together to deliver these Games
- The Paddles represents all Provinces and Regions of the Country






- Shell money in the 2023 represents

VENUES AND FACILITIES PLAN




Design MUSTS

- (Throwing events on Warm Up track area)




KGVI–Panatina Area



Matanikau Sport Park Plan


- ▶ 50 meter pool competition pool converted to part leisure pool







Accommodation



- ▶ 6 Local Schools to be refurbished and purposed as Village Accommodations– survey is completed and funding agreement in place to refurbish.
- ▶ Class room accommodations –similar to Vanuatu level—extra toilets and showers to be added
- ▶ Dining– similar to Samoa2019– Breakfast likely at accommodations, and one main dining hall at KGV I –SINU area
- ▶ No per diems as per bid– we will work on program with PGC to ensure ability to control peak numbers in order to provide sufficient services



Key Milestones

- ▶ NHA Legislative Act -in Place
- ▶ MOU on Main Stadium Signed with Contractor- July 9 2019
- ▶ All MOU's with Venue Owners to be in place by September
- ▶ Government Agreement on Core Funding- in place
- ▶ Secretariat in place
- ▶ Logo Launched
- ▶ Sports Solomon Fund to be established in August
