4 Reasons Why Parents 'Sideline Coaching' Must Stop

### 1. Confusing Players with Conflicting Instructions

This leaves the child in a tricky situation...

- Who should they listen to?
- Which adult do they choose to make happy?
- Which adult do they choose to disappoint?

Players are forced to choose.

2. Stealing Their Decision Making Opportunities

Learning how to make smart basketball decisions through experience is crucial for basketball development.

# 3. Takes Authority and Respect Away From the Coach

If a coach is willing to volunteer their time to coach your son or daughter, please let them do the coaching.

#### 4. Coaching the Referees

When coaching from the sidelines, some parents do more than scream out instructions to the players on the team...

There are many who decide to yell at referees, too.

Here are a few of the main negatives to doing this:

a. You're teaching your child to make excuses

When your child notices you complaining to the referee, they'll feel like they're allowed to do the same thing.

Instead, teach them to immediately move onto the next play.
