

## **Benalla Breakers Representative Basketball**

Parent / Guardian Agreement

As a Benalla Breakers Parent/Guardian you must agree to the following:

- Ensure your child makes a full commitment to the season, including attendance at training sessions and tournaments.
- Ensure your child arrives at tournament games at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each game.
- Respect the coach and the decisions they make.
- Ensure you do not approach the bench, coach or players during the game.
- Ensure you do not coach any player from the sidelines; this is the responsibility of the coach.
- Represent Benalla Basketball in a positive manner at all times. Lead by example to demonstrate good sportsmanship, applaud good play by all teams.
- Remember that children play for fun and enjoyment and that winning is only part of their motivation. Never ridicule children for making mistakes or losing a competition. See errors or losses as an opportunity to learn in a constructive way. Comment in a way that is positive.
- Role model and develop your child's respect for the ability of opponents as well as for the judgement of officials and coaches, and their interaction with parents and spectators.
- Abuse of any type is unacceptable behaviour and will not be tolerated.
- Accept decisions of all referees as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language or harassing players, coaches or officials.
- Benalla Basketball Association may ask a parent/guardian to leave the court area if they breach this agreement.
