The Lions had finally awakened but three last goals to Sale sealed the win and kept the minor premiership in sight.

Jack Lipman again starred with 68 hitouts and 19 disposals. For the second straight year Lipman has been among the League's top MVP candidates and continues to put in more dominate performances. Chris Laverty wound back the clock and was the leading disposal getter for the Pies with 30 disposals including 13 rebound 50's. Superstars Martin and

Jordy Dessent had 29 and 27 disposals respectively including 25 contested and 16 clearances between the pair.

James Blaser was the Lions best with 36 disposals. The 2017 Trood Award and Rodda medallist won plenty of the hard ball with 21 contested disposals and 8 clearances. Spencer White was a target up forward taking 10 marks for the day including 6 inside 50 grabs. 


