## 40 YEARS AGO ... 25TH AUGUST, 1979

Maffra scored a crucial win over top side Warragul in the match of the day for Round 17, 1979. The win secured for the Eagles their place in the finals as they were now two games clear of the pack with just one game left to play. The loss tumbled the Gulls from first to third and gave Maffra a psychological advantage as they met Warragul again a fortnight later in the 1st Semi-Final. With four goals in each of the first two quarters, Maffra went in at half time with a lead of 13 points. The third term was where the damage was done as the Eagles extended their lead to thirty points with a seven goal term. Warragul fought back in the last quarter but finished 14 points in arrears. Leongatha assumed top spot on the ladder with a thumping win over Sale. With Damian Hogan (6 goals) and Brendan Laube (5) on target, the Parrots raced to a 56 point half time lead which was almost doubled to 106 points by the final siren. Traralgon's Alan Jennings equalled the league goalkicking record of 14 goals against Newborough as the Maroons' forwards ran rampant. 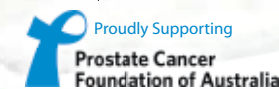
