Today, Dad is driving, but sometimes we go by train.




Dad is driving to Olympic Park. Yay, we are almost there!

I love AFL!




Nearly there! It is only a 5 minute walk to the stadium.




There it is.


Giants Stadium, my favourite place to be. It looks like they are fixing something over there.




First, the security guards check our bags. We are not allowed to take cans or glass into the stadium.



The security guards sometimes check people with a special wand. This is to make sure no-one takes anything inside that is not allowed.




The lady scans my ticket so I can go inside.
