INTRODUCTION

Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc supports the highest ethics and values relating to the sport of lacrosse. This will include the promotion of confidence in the management and governance of the organisation to ensure fair and honest performances and outcomes, unaffected by illegitimate enhancements or external interests or any other acts or practices which are contrary to the policies, procedures, rules and regulations governing the sport of lacrosse.

This policy provides the position of Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc with respect to the integrity of the sport within Queensland.

SCOPE

Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc will send a clear message to all stakeholders on the need to promote and strengthen the reputation of the sport of lacrosse. This will be achieved through these key messages;

Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc recognises that there are a number of 'threats' posed to the integrity of sport, including match fixing, results manipulation, gambling, doping, corruption, discrimination, general member protection issues, and unethical behaviour. The organisation will proactively identify and manage these risks at all times.

Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc will apply the rules, codes of conduct and good governance principles as important safeguards to protecting the integrity of lacrosse and lacrosse participants.

PURPOSE

This policy will help to ensure that Queensland Lacrosse Association Inc meets its obligation to the wider community to promote lacrosse as a sport for all and welcomes everyone to participate in a fair and safe environment.
