

Coach Accreditation Framework

Basketball Australia's vision is for every basketball coach in Australia to have completed a minimum level of formal education whilst working with players of all abilities.

Basketball Australia's national coach accreditation framework provides five tiers of accreditation, tailored to the needs of the players and program that the coach is involved with.

Accreditation Levels



* The Master Coach accreditation is an honorary accreditation bestowed by Basketball Australia on coaches with significant achievements at an international level.



Accreditation Recommendations

For each level of participation and for every coaching role within that level, Basketball Australia recommends that a coach hold the following accreditation level as a minimum:
