Recognition Requirements

To have the 10 credits recognised, documentation of completion for both Community Coach Accreditation and Club Coach Accreditation will need to be submitted.

Forms showing completion of involvement in development programs or team coaching are to be signed by an SA Country affiliated association and can be found on SA Country Basketball's website.

To have 10 credits recognised, students must complete the following:

Basketball Australia Community Coach Accreditation Online Assessment- 1 hour

SA Country Workshop attendance- 1.5 hour

Coaching at Aussie Hoops or equivalent mini hoops clinics- 1hr per week for 2 terms (20 hrs)

Total: 22.5 hrs

Basketball Australia Club Coach Accreditation Online Assessment, clinic and clinic assessement-8 hrs

Coaching at Community Development Program or coaching for a team- 1.5hrs per week for two terms (30 hrs)

Total: 38 hrs
