

### HISTORY IN THE MAKING

Aldinga Football Club has a long history stretching back to 1879, in the early years, games were organised on an ad hoc basis against any visiting team or neighbouring teams with no premiership tables or finals games.

With the establishment of the Southern Football Association in 1886 football began to be more organised with a competition which eventually lead to end of season finals becoming a regular event. To the best of our knowledge our first finals participation was in 1923 when we featured in a Semi Final against a team called Hillside who defeated us by 9 points. In 1924 we once again played in the semi-final and this time scored our first win defeating McLaren Vale by 5 points. It is unclear what happened after this game as there is no record of Aldinga's progress in the remaining finals games. In 1925 we defeated the minor premiers Noarlunga by 3 points to move straight into our first grand final unfortunately we lost by 2 goals against McLaren Vale. We continued to inch closer to that elusive premiership in 1926 when we defeated McLaren Vale to advance to another grand final only to lose to Noarlunga by 9 points.

In 1927 we were able to entice Horrie Leaker to return to play for us, a local lad who had starred with SANFL club Sturt's winning grand final team in 1926 and who at only 23 years of age was in the prime of his playing career. Our 1927 team completed the minor round undefeated and comfortably defeated Willunga by 7 goals in the semi-final. We would have approached the Grand Final against Hillside in a confident frame of mind. In what must have been a major surprise we lost the grand final in a close game by a solitary point. For-

tunately for us the Southern Football Association had a rule which gave the minor premier the right to challenge for a rematch in the event that they did not win the premiership. Consequently we were able to play in the Challenge final the following week and in a close fought game in which we trailed deep into the last quarter due largely to our inaccuracy we managed to kick a late goal to claim our first premiership defeating Hillside 6-6 (36) to Aldinga 5-13 (37).

Our success in 1927 was the beginning of a run of six premierships in a row, which still remains as a record for the most consecutive premierships in SFL senior competitions. After losing the preliminary final in 1933 we returned in 1934 to claim one last flag.

With only the occasional finals appearance and no premiership success the club went into recess in 1952 and did not re-emerge until 1977 and it was in 1987 when our reserve team broke through to win our first premiership in the modern era that we tasted victory. This was followed with senior premierships in 1991 and 1993 as well as junior premierships in 1994 and 2001.

2019 has seen the emergence of our ladies senior team and our u14 girls team both will be competing in grand finals to-day and as a club we look forward to sharing with them the joy of victory or the pain of defeat as they write another chapter in the history of the Sharks
