2020 JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Congratulations to all U12 Boys and Girls who have been selected to represent Penrith Basketball Association in the 2020 Metropolitan Junior Championships.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: All athletes and guardians please ensure you fulfil the obligations below to secure your place in the 2020 program.

- **COMPULSORY UNIFORM ORDERS** - All athletes are now required to attend representative Uniform Fitting/Order sessions. ****(Only athletes who represented Penrith in 2019 and do not require any new uniforms in 2020 are exempt. Note: Rep socks will be available to order for 2020).*
- No payment required at time of order. Penrith staff will assist with all uniform fittings and orders.

U12 Girls – Thursday 21st November 5.30pm to 6.30pm

U12 Boys – Thursday 21st November 6.30pm to 7.30pm

- **AGE GROUP SKILLS** - All U12 players will commence squad skills sessions on Saturday mornings 7.00am to 8.15am on 23rd November, 30th November, 7th December, 14th December.
- **REPRESENTATIVE LEVY** – Instalment One of \$100.00 is due by Friday 13th December. The Active Kids Voucher is accepted for Representative Levy. Instalment Two of \$100.00 is due by 29th March with final instalment of \$350.00 due by 4th July.
- **Development Player Levy** has been set at \$275 which includes Saturday morning squad skills plus all team training. Instalment One of \$100 is due by Friday 13th December with balance due by 29th March. ****Development Players are only required to purchase representative shorts, training singlet and Hoodie.*
- **PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT FORM** – All athletes selected to our representative program **MUST COMPLETE AND RETURN** the Representative Behaviour and Agreement Form no later than **FRIDAY 22ND NOVEMBER**.
- **PLAYERS REQUIRING A CLEARANCE FROM OTHER ASSOCIATIONS:** Any player selected at Penrith who represented an Association other than Penrith will need to have a Clearance approved by BNSW. There are strict rules relating to transfers/clearances between Associations. Penrith Basketball staff will request this clearance on your behalf, if required. Denial will result in removal from the Penrith program.
- **REPRESENTATIVE TRAINING:** Midweek training will begin in the New Year once a schedule has been approved between the Association and your Team Coach. This information will be communicated to you by your Team Coach and or Manager.
