Hot Weather Policy

Summer 2019/20



The staff at 'Life. Be in it' Sport for All - Unley & Immanuel are well aware of the discomfort hot weather brings while playing at our Stadiums and we take steps to ensure that such discomfort is kept to a minimum.

In addition to the automatic cancellations & modifications listed in our Junior & Senior Hot Weather Policies, Management reserves the right to cancel or modify the playing times of the competition on any given day/night if the playing conditions are deemed to be extreme. Only in this unlikely event will team contacts be notified via phone.

Parents, coaches & team managers can also help by:

- Ensuring that participants are adequately hydrated prior to, during and after activity
- Ascertain whether any participants have any known medical conditions which may be affected by the conditions
- Make use of all available substitute players as appropriate
- Utilise all available Time-Outs

These Policies have been developed taking into consideration the following:

- Sports Medicine Australia guidelines
- We operate in an indoor environment
- The stadiums have been designed to allow ventilation
- Exit doors can be opened to improve air flow around the courts
- Exhaust fans are installed in the ceiling to assist in the removal of warm air
- Drinking water is freely available in the foyer of each Centre
- The majority of programs are generally not held during the hottest part of the day (1pm-5pm)

Staff will make the decision to modify or cancel games if the forecasted temperature according to the Bureau of Meteorology is:

36°C

If the forecasted temperature is 36°C or higher as of the 8am Bureau of Meteorology forecast on the day of competition all Junior matches & School Holiday Programs will be CANCELLED.

34°C

If the forecasted temperature is 34°C or higher as of the 8am Bureau of Meteorology forecast on the day of competition all Junior matches scheduled at our outdoor, overflow venues (Cabra College & Trinity Baptist) will be CANCELLED.


32°C

If the forecasted temperature is 32°C or higher as of the 8am Bureau of Meteorology forecast on the day of competition all Junior matches will be modified as below:

Basketball & Soccer (Futsal): Halves will be shortened to 15 Minutes, half time will be extended to 3 minutes and referees will call a timeout at the halfway point of each half.

Netball: Quarters will be shorted to 7 minutes and quarter & half time breaks will be extended by a minute each.

SHP: More drinks breaks will be organised during sessions.

Senior Competitions & Stadium Shutdown

Staff will make the decision to modify or cancel games if the forecasted temperature according to the Bureau of Meteorology is:

Game Cancellations:

Phase 1: At 4:30pm — If the current temperature is 38°C or higher at 4:30pm according to the Bureau of Meteorology Adelaide observation on the day of competition all Senior matches scheduled at 6pm & 6:50pm at Unley & Immanuel (6:30 & 7:20 at St Johns) will be CANCELLED.

Phase 2: At 6pm— A decision will be made by management according to indoor court data monitored half hourly, and predicted outdoor temperatures, for all senior matches scheduled 7:40pm onwards.

Weekend Programs If the forecasted temperature is 38°C or higher as of the 8am Bureau of Meteorology forecast on the day of competition all Senior matches will be CANCELLED.

Centre Closure: If the current temperature is 38°C or higher according to the Bureau of Meteorology Adelaide observation, the Centre will be closed and all court hire/casual shooting will be CANCELLED. The centre will re-open at the discretion of management.

34°C or higher as of the 4:30pm Bureau of Meteorology Adelaide observation on the day of the competition, all Senior matches will be modified as below:

> Basketball & Soccer (Futsal): Halves will be shortened to 19 Minutes, half time will be extended to 3 minutes and referees will call a timeout at the halfway point of each half.

Netball: Quarters will be shorted to 9 minutes and quarter & half time breaks will be extended by a minute each.
