Albury Basketball has nominated to enter the number of teams you will see below for the upcoming SJL Season. BNSW has changed the way Officials (referees) are to be nominated and there are quotas that must be met based on the number of teams you enter and the age divisions you enter them in.

Albury Basketball has been informed by BNSW that at the current time we have not met their requirements which may impact the number of teams they will allow us to enter. We are in continued discussions with BNSW to work toward finding a solution however at the time of writing this announcement this remains unresolved.

In the event a decision is made by BNSW to not let the Albury Basketball Association enter the number of teams we would like to, the Association will look at other opportunities (e.g. Basketball Tournaments) for those athletes that may miss out on an opportunity to compete in the SJL.

We will provide further updates as they come to hand.
