


ALBURY WODONGA CHILDREN ACTIVITIES

Albury Botanic Gardens	Cnr Smollett Street & Wodonga Place, Albury	Hidden within the shade and beauty of the Albury Botanic Gardens, the Children's Garden is a place where children can let their imagination run wild. Highlights include a life-sized dinosaur with interactive speaking tubes, living cubbies, a fairy temple, a wetland and creek line, and a troll cave. Open 8.30am until sunset. Closed every Wednesday except during NSW School Holidays.
Oddies Creek Adventure Playspace	Off Wodonga Place, Albury	Suitable for children from babies to teenagers, the playground has a range of features including a giant flying fox, a large climbing net and an observation deck. This is an ideal spot for a family day out surrounded by green open space, only metres from the Murray River and BBQ's.
Belvoir Park	Sumsion Gardens Osburn or Huon Streets, Wodonga	A super-sized playground with climbing equipment, tunnels, swings (including Liberty Swing for Wheelchair access), observation decks and slides; this playground caters for babies through to young teenagers. Onsite you'll find BBQ facilities, access to walking tracks and a large lagoon with ducks and swans. Dog lovers will love testing their K9's skills around the Dog Agility Park.
