## Indemnity, Terms and Conditions

I acknowledge that playing any sport (including basketball) carries the risk of personal injury.

St Bernard's Old Collegians Basketball Club Inc. recommends the following:

- all players wear a mouth guard whilst training and playing;

- adequate medical insurance and a current ambulance subscription is held for all players;

- a parent of each player is in attendance at all games and training sessions to ensure that an up to date medical history is available to any person providing assistance to an injured player.

I hereby authorise my child to participate in basketball, and acknowledge that basketball is a fast moving game and although categorised as a non-contact sport, incidents unfortunately do occur. I will endeavour to be present or ensure a responsible adult is present at all games, training sessions and other basketball activities in which my child is involved.

In the event of an emergency, I authorise the coach or team manager in charge to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, for my child to receive such medical treatment as may be deemed necessary and I agree to bear any costs associated therewith.

I indemnify St Bernard's Old Collegians Basketball Club Inc. its servants and agents against all claims arising from my child's participation in the club's activities that are not covered by Basketball Victoria's insurance.

I acknowledge that my child and I are bound by the Club's, Association's and Basketball Victoria's Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Codes of Conduct and subject to the jurisdiction of any basketball tribunal or other disciplinary bodies.

I acknowledge that photographs and videos of my child and me may be made and I consent that they may be used for promotion of the Club and basketball generally. I will not photograph or video any activity in which my child is involved unless I make myself known to the coach or team manager.

I acknowledge that my child and I and others in our company must conduct themselves in accordance with Basketball Victoria's Codes of Conduct, a copy of which is available from Basketball Victoria, and at the Keilor Basketball Association's webpage.

I acknowledge and support the Social Media Policy that the club has and understand the consequences that will result if breach of this policy.

I understand that the success of the club depends on volunteers and I will offer my services to assist the club in any way that is viable.
