



CLOSURE OF THE PENRITH VALLEY REGIONAL SPORTS CENTRE – COVID 19

Suspension of Penrith Basketball competitions and programs.

On Saturday 14th March 2020, the PVRSC took the precautionary measure to close its doors to the public until further notice. Management will be meeting again this week to discuss all options available and to consider updated health information.

This closure is likely to be no less than two weeks at this stage.

As a result of this closure, Penrith Basketball must immediately suspend all programs and competitions

Penrith Basketball management and staff will consider all options available to them with regard to finalising our current season. This may include:

- Where games are not able to be completed as of midday Saturday 14th March until the last scheduled competition round, double points may be awarded for a corresponding game in a previous round.
- If the double points option is not available, staff will consider other alternatives to ensure all teams are given equal opportunity with regard to competition points.
- If no semi-final or Grand Final is able to be played the PDBA will then declare a Premier and Runner Up accordingly and organise prizemoney or trophies.

For the upcoming Winter 2020 season, competition dates will be reviewed pending advice from PVRSC management and ongoing updates from medical authorities.

Updated information will be regularly available via social media, websites and email.
