Our junior netball teams have had a very successful history.

The Avoca Netball Club introduced the Under 15 team in 1963 so they are now in there 57th year. (They are now the 17 & Under team)

In that time Avoca 3rd's have played in 25 Grand Finals winning 14 Premierships and 11 times Runner's Up. In the 16 year period from 1983 to 1998 Avoca played in 14 Grand Finals winning 8 Premierships.

The Avoca Netball Club introduced the Under 15 Reserves team in 1968 so they are now in there 52nd year. (They are now the 15 & Under team)

In that time Avoca 4th's have played in 29 Grand Finals winning 20 Premierships and 9 times Runner's Up. In the first 9 years Avoca played in 8 Grand Finals winning six premierships. 5 in a row.

From 1986 to 1996 Avoca played in 11 straight Grand Finals winning 8 premierships.


