Points of COVID-19 transmission risk Stage 2-3

Identified risk areas

- Entry and Exit access to Venues
- Benches, Chairs and grandstand seating used
- Score bench tables
- Basketball
- Sanitation stations
- Attendance register sign in
- Any stationery items used

Responsible official

Our Biosecurity officer for that session, is to ensure that Moreton Bay Basketball adhere to our cleaning protocols through educating volunteers on common transmission points and the frequency that common areas are needing to be cleaned.

Strategies to mitigate risk areas

All common transmission points are to be wiped down with a 1 use antibacterial wipe for each area and disposed of correctly.

- Entry and Exit access to Venues to be cleaned after every session/game
- Benches, Chairs and grandstand seating used to be cleaned after every session/game
- Score bench tables to be cleaned after every session/game unless score bench officials are remaining for the following game/games
- Basketball to be cleaned at half time of each game
- Sanitation stations to be cleaned after every session/game
- Attendance register sign in to be cleaned after every session/game
- Any stationery items used to be cleaned after every use unless same user is using it
