Covid-19 Safety Procedures - Player Responsibilities

Stage Three -From 1st June

Before Training (at home)

We highly recommend all parents, guardians, players, coaches and support staff download the CovidSafe App on your mobile device. Please ensure this is active and your Bluetooth turned on.

- If you are unwell **DO NOT** attend training. Please advise your coach as we need to maintain a register of attendees.
- All players are to arrive at the ground dressed ready to train. Access to changerooms is limited and should be avoided where possible.
- Each player is to bring and take home their own drink bottle. The drink bottle must be clearly labelled. The club will not be supplying drink bottles. Under no circumstance are bottles to be shared. All drink bottles must be taken home at the conclusion of training.

On Arrival (at club)

- Players are to arrive and must go through the entry point and register before training. No player is to commence training until they have registered. (see diagram)
- Players will then be directed to their training zone area with their group leader.
- No parents, guardians or siblings are permitted on the oval, and must remain in their cars or the tiered parking area observing social distancing requirements.
- All players are to sanitise their hands prior to commencing training.
- Practice social distancing rules no physical contact, high fives etc..
- No spitting (salvia or water) this will not be tolerated.
- Players to stay in the allotted 20 persons per group.
- Contact allowed under game simulation drills.

Conclusion and Departing Training

All players will sanitise their hands and be directed to leave the oval area immediately after training through the Exit point.

No socialising, meetings or gathering post training.

Keeping you safe

All coaches and team leaders have undertaken an online Covidsafe Course.

All equipment will be cleaned and sanitised before and after each training session.

A Covid Safe medical Officer (Debra Mackey) will be present to observe Covidsafe requirements are met as well as provide emergency first aid should it be required.
