Geordie has been playing since 2014 and has already played his 100th game last season and kicked 44 goals.

Geordie played his 100th game in the 2019 Grand Final and as an Under 14.5 premiership player, Geordie was a key part of our victory kicking 21 goals for the season.

Geordie had an outstanding season in 2017 when he was a top age Under 11.5 player. He was the winner of the Under 11.5 Best & Fairest and was 3rd in the MCDFNL equivalent polling 26 votes.

We look forward to watching Geordie progress through the ranks in the coming years.

Paige played her first season of netball for Avoca last season in the 17 & Under team and immediately made her mark when she finished Runner Up in the Best & Fairest.

Paige is better known for her football prowess and in 2018 she finished 5th in our Under 14.5 club Best & Fairest polling 46 votes.

Paige transferred to play Womens football in the AFL Goldfields Under 18 competition in 2019 and showed that she has a promising future when she won the AFL Goldfield Best & Fairest Player as a 15 year old. She also won the Rookie of the Year and was named in the Team of the year.

Leah Harris is considered to be one of the greatest ever players for the Avoca Netball Club.


Leah has contributed at administration and playing level during her time with the club from 1980 to 1993.

Colleen Harris/Drummond is also considered to be one of Avoca's greatest netballers who has played over 450 games for the club.

Colleen first played netball for the club way back in 1982 in the Under 14's and was lucky enough to play in a premiership in her first season of netball.

She then played the next two season's in the Under 16 grade which resulted in two more premierships and an Under 16 Best & Fairest award in 1983 and a Runner Up Best & Fairest by one vote to Helen Hamer in 1984.

Because of Colleen's uncanny goal shooting ability, she was promoted to the Senior team in 1985 to form a deadly goal shooting alliance with her sister Leah Harris, who also was a



quality player with a number of Club and League Best & Fairest awards to her name.

Avoca won consecutive Lexton Netball Association Premiership from 1986 to 1990 and Colleen played in all of these premierships and was Captain in 1987, 88 & 89.
