REFUNDS

All players who are not playing this season due to safety concerns are entitled to a refund of registration fees, less the fees charged by SportsTG. If you require a refund, please email me at lindisfarnejuniorfootballclub@gmail.com and we will send thru your details to the STJFL to process a refund back to the card or account that was initially used to pay the original transaction.

REGISTRATION FEES

The STJFL have advised at Monday 29 June President's meeting, that there will be a 30% reduction in team nomination fees, due to the reduced number of games. A reasonable solution. The STIFL have also recommended that clubs NOT refund families, given the additional expenses of COVID-19, (e.g.) equipment, cleaning products & sanitiser. While we support this decision, the committee are not comfortable that families who have supported our club, do not receive financial compensation for a shortened season. As we have successfully applied for a number of grants and at our club committee meeting on Tuesday 30 June, the committee discussed a number of options, to come up with a reasonable solution:

- Arranging a refund which is problematic for a volunteer organisation
- Issuing a voucher which is problematic for a volunteer organisation
- Issuing a voucher to be used on clothing given the COVID-19 crisis, this is again, problematic
- Holding an end of season event to celebrate the season, at no cost players

The committee have decided that the most appropriate and fair solution is to hold a free, end of season event for both JUNIORS and YOUTH players.

TICKET TO PLAY

After feedback from community clubs and lobbying from peak advocacy body (Clubs Tasmania), the Ticket to Play scheme has been increased from 1 July 2020.

Ticket to Play will now provide two vouchers up to \$100 in value towards club membership for children aged 5 - 17 years and listed on a Centrelink Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card or in Out of Home Care.
