

GET READY - Basketball is still planning to be back the week of the 17th August.

Albury Basketball Association is looking forward to having our junior basketballers back on court

To make this happen we need everyone in our basketball community to be helpful, compliant and kind. Things will look and operate a bit different for the foreseeable future and we are asking everyone to be supportive of what we need to do to get our competitions up and running.

- **We will need volunteers to help out and will call for expressions of interest this week**
- All players **MUST** come ready to play. Boots and uniform **MUST** be on before entering the stadium
- You **MUST** know what court you are playing on and your game time when you arrive at the stadium
- You **Must** be on time to your game. Arrive 10 minutes before your game, not early and not late. If you arrive early you will not be permitted in the Stadium
- It will be **STRICTLY** one player / one spectator (no additional spectators or siblings)
- **NO** basketballs can be brought into the stadium, we will provide them
- Once games are finished you **MUST** leave the stadium, no hanging around
- **ALL** people entering the stadium **MUST** provide contact details.
- Players will be recorded on the score sheet through Sports TG System
- **ALL** others will be recorded using a QR Code scanner or your mobile device. If you do not have an iPhone we recommend you download a QR Code scanning app to your device. A paper sign in sheet will also be available at the score bench.
- We need all clubs to ensure they have Coaches ready to go 10 min before game time. We would also ask all teams to roster team managers and scorers for each week to help manage teams.
- Teams will muster at the front of the stadium and move through to their court as a team.
- Spectators will enter the stadium after the teams enter the stadium
- Groups of people **MUST** not gather outside the stadium or in the foyer

Game payments

This will be a 15-week season and games fees have been discounted to \$75 for the season (This does not include any player registrations that may fall due)

For those people that pay for the season as an out of pocket expense please note:

- In the event the season does not start due to Covid Restrictions the \$75 payment will be fully refundable
- Once the season starts and in the event the season needed to be cancelled refunds will be paid less the number of games played (reduced by \$5.00 per game)

****People can choose to pay for the season using Active Kids Vouchers but please remember, in accordance with the NSW Office of Sport Policy, Active Kids Vouchers are not refundable and once used cannot be used again.**

***** Due to the current restrictions in place in Victoria we are unable to accept registrations from players that are residents of Victoria or have a Victorian residential address.**

We can't make this season happen without your support and compliance. At game time please follow the direction of the Marshals and Covid Safety Officers. Keep an eye-out for further communications as we approach the resumption of play date.

To all our Victorian/Wodonga based members and members who cannot or choose not to return to play basketball in Season 2 and DID NOT use an Active Kids Voucher to pay for Season 1 fees, we ask that you please make an application to the Albury Basketball Association in writing by email to admin@alburybasketball.com.au to request a partial refund for season 1 game fees ONLY. Please note the yearly registration fee is non-refundable and all applications must be approved by the ABA Board.
