Flash dad foils theft

A HAVE-a-go hero wearing only his underwear jumped into a moving car to thwart thieves who were stealing his car in the middle of the night.

Father of three Rowan Pascoe, 34, ran from his Emerald house about 2am yesterday to confront the two men getting away in his 1985 Falcon ute.

At only 160cm tall, pocket dynamo Mr Pascoe sprinted from his back door, wrenched open the passenger door of the car and dived into the vehicle to grab hold of the steering wheel.

In the wild struggle, the car accelerated and swung off the road, ploughed through a small tree, dived over one embankment and crashed head-on into another.

Mr Pascoe said at one stage the car was up on two wheels.

"I just didn't want my car taken because it's my livelihood," said the bricklayer, who has lost two cars to thieves in the past.

He said he was "half-awake" when he heard the car start and the engine revving.

He raced out of the house in his underpants and a T-shirt.

"I reached in to grab the wheel and the guy popped me one," he said.

Mr Pascoe's father, Don, said his son dragged the driver from the car and punched him repeatedly until he cried for mercy.

He said his son, who is captain-coach of Emerald Football Club reserves, was short but built like a bull.

He passed in where the car had crashed, Mr Pascoe said.

All he got was a cut on his knuckles.

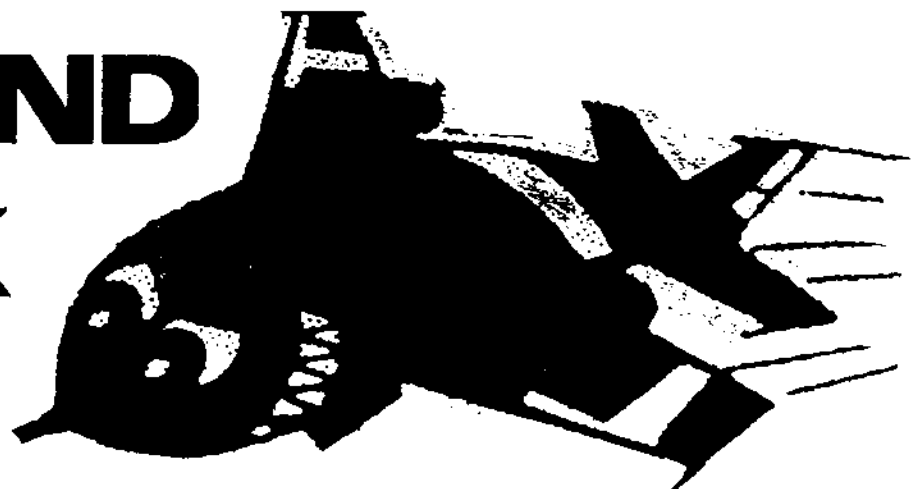

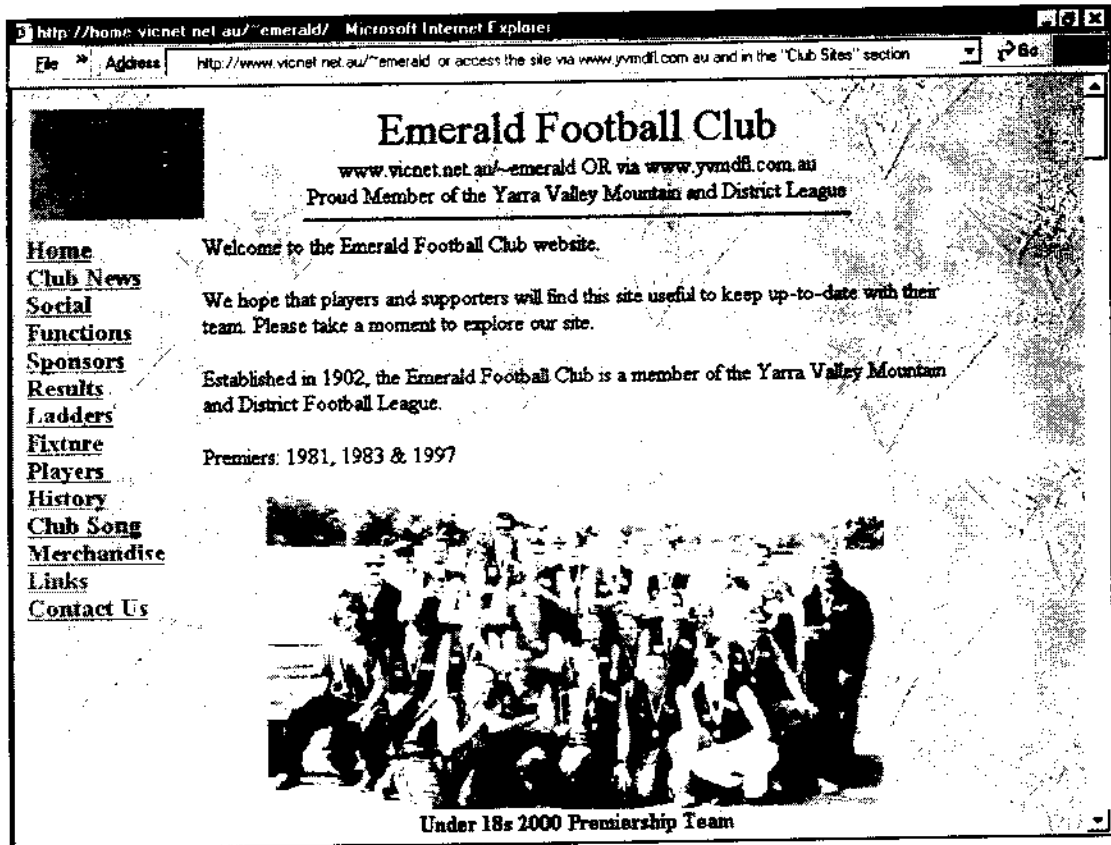
